Name	Function
Volume button	Adjust the volume.
Power button	Long press to turn on the walkie-talkie.
PTT key	It is directly connected to the key to enter the microphone function. It enters the receiver function, press the key to separate the PTT extension function.
Back key	Directly key
Menu key	It is the start of the menu, press the key to enter the repeat menu operation function. It is the walkie-talkie function, the function is the same as the side key. It is the walkie-talkie function, when entering the function for group member list, you can select the list. It is the temporary group for intercom.
Return key	Return to the previous menu during menu operation.
Return key	When editing a new message, press the key to delete the character in front of the cursor and long press the key to delete all characters in front of the cursor.
Navigation key	Move the selection bar during a menu operation.

Install the SIM card

- Make sure the SIM card is inserted with the chip side up and the gold side down.

3.2 Power on

A three-wire "Power On" button is located on the power-on button on the back of the machine. Press the button to power on the machine, and the machine will power on the display screen.

Battery charging

- Use the original charger for charging.
- Press the charge key to charge when the first use.
- Plug the charger into the matching part of the interface.
- Plug the charger into the power socket and start charging.
- After charging, using the charger from the power socket, and then using the intercom.
- Press the power button to turn the battery indicator light on, indicating that the battery is fully charged.

C. Switch groups

a. Press the "Menu" key to enter the menu list and enter the "Selected Group" menu.

b. Press the "Menu" key to enter the group and view the group member list.

c. Press the "Back" key to return and press the "PTT" key to send voice.

Note: When the voice broadcast is not finished, pressing the PTT key will not respond. You need to wait until it is finished, and then press the PTT key to start the intercom.

D. Selective call function

a. This machine has two selective calling modes, group selective calling and friends selective calling.

b. Group members: When using this method, each member cannot join more than 64 groups, and the total number of members of all groups joined by the user cannot exceed 200, otherwise the walkie-talkie may not be used normally.

E. Send mode

When you press the PTT key, when the transmit light is on, it means to enter the transmit mode, and the other party will be able to hear what you say. When a higher level user initiates a talkback, while sending, it will exit the sending mode and enter the receiving mode. At this time, you can only passively receive the voice of the other party, and if the other party cannot hear what you say, if you keep pressing the PTT key, you will enter the sending mode directly when the other party finishes sending. When in transmit mode, the LCD screen displays "TX" (TX is in speaking).

- All users will be assigned speech permissions, which are high, medium and low respectively.
- High-priority users can steal the speech of low-priority users.

F. Receive mode

When the receiving light is on, it indicates that the other party's speech is received. The receiving intercom mode is exited in the following cases:

When the priority of the local machine is higher than that of the other party, pressing the PTT key will enter the sending mode.

When in receive mode, the opposite user name is displayed on the LCD screen.

a. Take the group list as an example, the usage method is as follows (friends and members use the same way, only the background settings are different).

b. Press the "Menu" key to enter the menu.

c. Press the "Menu" key to enter the group list.

d. Select the group of the user who wants to talk alone, and press the "Menu key" to enter. Groups to view a list of the members of that group.

e. Select the user who wants to talk alone in the group (only the online user can make a selective call, and the offline user cannot make a selective call), and press the "Menu key" to select.

f. Press the PTT key to create a temporary group.

g. After the intercom is completed, press the "Back" key to exit and return to the current group.

Note: Only the online user (that is, the other party has been powered on and successfully logged in) can make a selective call.
