

# WIRELESS EARBUDS

## R19 User manual

### I. Key Instructions and Functions

- 1.Power On: Take the earphones out of the charging case. The earphones will automatically turn on and start pairing. Alternatively, long – press the touch key for about 3 – 5 seconds to power on.
- 2.Power Off: Put the earphones back into the charging case, and they will automatically power off. Or long – press the touch key for about 3 – 5 seconds to power off.
- 3.Play/Pause: During playback, single – click the touch key of one earphone to pause the playback. Single – click again to resume playback when it is paused.
- 4.Answer/Hang up Calls: When there is an incoming call, single – click the touch key of one earphone to answer the call. To end the call, single – click the touch key of one earphone to hang up.
- 5.Reject Calls: When there is an incoming call, long – press the touch key of the earphone for 2 – 3 seconds to reject the call.
- 6.Double – click to Adjust Tracks: Double – click to skip to the previous or next track.
- 7.Triple – click to Adjust Volume: Triple – click to adjust the volume.

### II. Pairing and Connecting

How do I power on and pair the earphones?

- 1.Remove the earphones from the charging case. The earphones will automatically power on and initiate the pairing process. Turn on the wireless function of your phone, search for the earphones, and then connect. If you experience problems like only one earphone getting connected or the device not being detected, place both earphones back into the charging case. Then take them out again, wait for approximately 5 seconds, turn on the wireless function of your phone (if it was turned off), and search for and connect to the earphones once more.

### III. Precautions for Use

- 1.Please do not treat this product violently. Do not squeeze it with heavy objects, and keep it away from high - temperature and high - humidity environments.
  - 2.Keep it away from other high - frequency transmitting devices, as this may affect the signal reception of this device, causing audio stuttering and disconnection.
  - 3.Please use this product within an effective environment, and there should be no physical obstacles (such as walls) between the wireless device and the earphones.
  - 4.When charging, please use a charger with an output not exceeding 5V - 2A to charge this case.
