

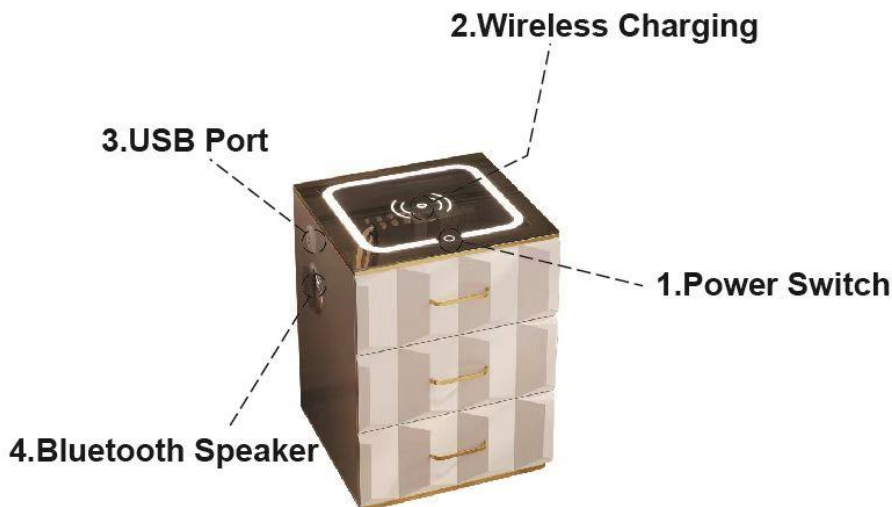
Nightstand Installation

Before the Installation

1. Do not throw away packing materials until assembly is complete for small parts may come loose inside the carton during shipment. If parts are missing, please contact us.
2. Assemble this item on a soft surface, such as carpet to protect the finish
3. Periodically check to ensure that all connections are tight.

Care and Cleaning

1. To protect the finish, avoid use chemicals and household cleaners.
2. All hot serving dishes should be placed on a pad.
3. Any liquid spilled onto the top should be cleaned up immediately with a damp cloth



1. Before using this product, please connect the power through the adapter.
2. Bluetooth Speaker: Open your mobile phone to search for Bluetooth, connect according to the prompts.

4. Wireless Charging: Place your device with wireless charging directly on the countertop and it will charge properly.
5. USB Port: Use the charging cable to power electronic devices.
