



Panel functions:




- 1. Light ON/OFF
- 2. Short press to PLAY/PAUSE the music.
- 3. Short press to the next song
- 4. Volume + Control
- 5. Press the EQ button into EQ control.
- 6. Volume - Control
- 7. Short press to the previous song
- 8. Mode Button

External jack function :

- DC5V
- External DC 5V power supply.
- USB/TF
- Support to play music file stored in the memory card,
- MIC jack
- Connecting external microphone.

Cautions



Please charge the machine before use if it is not used for over 1 month

Trouble Shooting

No electricity

First check that the power switch is on (switch is in a state of "NO" to open). If the above situation, please turn off the power and connect the power cord to the machine after charging, or plugged in, let the machine work while charging.

Noise of speaker

Speaker has the property of low noise, sometimes the background noise of the music player and computer sound card is several times higher than that of the speaker. Therefore, please unplug the audio wire of the speaker when checking, and the noise of the speaker shall not be heard at 0.5m away.

Charging Instruction:

Please plug in the power cable to charge the speaker and the charging indicator is on at the same time.
Please power off the speaker while it's charging.
Charge time is about 4 hours.
5mA charging current to protect the battery.
Please plug in the power cable to power on the speaker if the battery is damaged.
