连接及播放

• 蓝牙

开机后蓝色指示灯慢闪, 音箱进入蓝牙待配对状态; 打开手机蓝牙并找到蓝牙名“CYB-X3S”点击连接; 连接成功后蓝灯常亮。

• TWS互联

◦ 两台“CYB-X3S”近距离下同时进入蓝牙待配对状态 (确保蓝牙已断开其他设备); 选择其中一台为主音箱并长按“EQ”键2S, 此时主音箱黄色指示灯闪烁, 音箱进入TWS自动配对;
◦ 配对成功后主、副音箱黄灯亮, 主音箱蓝灯快闪;
◦ 找到蓝牙名“CYB-X3S”点击连接, 连接成功后主音箱蓝灯常亮。

• AUX音频线

将AUX线分别插入手机和音箱, 连接成功后蓝灯常亮。

• Type-C线

将Type-C线分别插入电脑和音箱, 连接成功后蓝红指示灯常亮。

• TF卡 (最高支持64G)

将TF卡插入音箱后, 音箱自动播放卡中歌曲, 此时蓝色指示灯常亮; TF卡支持APE/FLAC/WMV/WAV/MP3格式播放

• NFC

手机开启NFC后, 靠近音箱NFC感应区域; 感应成功则手机自动打开蓝牙并弹出连接对话框, 点击连接, 连接成功后蓝灯常亮。

Connect and play

• BT

After booting, the blue light flashes slowly, and the speaker enters the BT pairing state; Turn on the mobile phone BT and find the BT name of "CYB-X3S" and click connect; After the connection is successful, the blue light is always on.

• AUX audio

Plug the AUX cable into the phone and the speaker respectively; After the connection is successful, the blue light is always on.

• Type-C audio

Plug the Type-C cable into the computer and speaker, and the blue and red indicator lights will stay on after the connection is successful.

• TWS

◦ Two “CYB-X3S” enter the BT pairing state at close range and the same time (make sure BT is disconnected from other devices);
◦ Select one of the main speakers and long press the "EQ" button 2S;
◦ The yellow light of the main speaker flashes quickly and the speakers enter TWS automatic pairing;
◦ After the pairing is successful, the yellow light of the main and auxiliary speakers stays on, and the blue light of the main speaker flashes quickly;
◦ Find the BT name "CYB-X3S" and click Connect;
◦ After the connection is successful, the blue light is always on of the main speaker.

• TF card (up to 64G)

After inserting the TF card into the speaker, the speaker automatically plays the song in the card, and the blue indicator light is always on at this time; TF card supports APE / FLAC / WMV / WAV / MP3 format playback

• NFC

After NFC is turned on, the mobile phone is close to the NFC sensing area of the speaker; If the sensing is successful, the mobile phone automatically turns on BT and displays a connection dialog; click Connect, and the blue light is always on after the connection is successful.

	Long press	Long press 2S to turn on / off; Speaker freeze status, long press 8S to reset.
	Short press	Switch sound effects: clear vocals, heavy bass, light music.
	Long press	BT to be connected: Long press 2S to enter TWS pairing mode; TWS paired status: long press 2S to exit TWS pairing.
	Short press	Short press to switch playback mode: BT, AUX, Type-C or TF card playback mode;
	Long press	BT connected status: Long press 5S to clear memory;

	Short press	1. Music playback status: Short press to pause / play; 2. Incoming call status: Short press to connect the call; 3. When the call has been answered: Short press to hang up; 4. BT connected status: Quickly double-click to dial the last outgoing call from the phone.
	Long press	BT connected status: Long press 2S to wake up the mobile assistant; Incoming call status: Long press 2S to reject the call.
	Short press	Volume down;
	Long press	Long press 2S to switch to the previous song;
	Short press	Volume up;
	Long press	Long press 2S to switch to the next song.
