Rechargeable lithium battery



USB charging port

Switch

First turn the switch button at the bottom to the power position, then the pet will have a sound prompt; if there is no remote control for a long time, the pet will power off by itself, and it needs to be turned back on when playing again.

Charging instructions

- Insert the TYPE-C connector of the charging cable into the charging port on the body.
- Insert the other end of the charging cable into the USB charging connector. The charging light on the body is red, indicating that the charging state is in.
- About 1.5 hours of charging, the charging light of the fastener is off, indicating that the charging is complete. Please disconnect all connections and put the safety position.

Battery precautions

- When charging, personnel should not leave and the charging time is not easy to be too long. If the battery is found not to charge, the charging process, please stop charging immediately and stop battery disposal or fire.
- Do not put the battery near fire or other heat sources. Do not use the battery in use or charging process once the smell or battery sudden heat, deformation, discoloration and other abnormal phenomena, please immediately stop using the battery.
- If fire occurs, please immediately stop using the battery.
- Do not use the original charger to charge the product, and make sure that the voltage of the charger meets your local standards.
- Do not put the battery in the fire, enclosure over or pressure container.

Remote control introduction



Use a screwdriver to unscrew the back cover of the remote control, install the battery in the correct positive and negative directions, and then install the battery (3 x 1.5 AAA batteries required).



BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

- The smart dog uses a non-replaceable 3.7V lithium battery, and the remote control uses three 1.5V AAA non-rechargeable batteries.
- The battery should be taken out and packed correctly according to the polarity and voltage signs on the battery compartment, and the battery should not be short-circuited.
- Non-rechargeable batteries cannot be charged.
- Rechargeable batteries must be charged under adult supervision.
- When the rechargeable battery is charging, the toy switch should be turned off.
- Different types of batteries or old and new batteries cannot be mixed.
- Only batteries with the same or equivalent recommended battery can be used.
- The exhausted battery should be removed from the toy. If it is not used for a long time, please remove the battery from the toy.
- Do not short-circuit the power terminal.
- Do not connect to more than the recommended amount of power supply. USB cable in the process of use should regularly check its wire, plug. If the shell and other parts are damaged, the use should be stopped when the damage is found until the repair is complete.

Smart dog function introduction



Press the button of the remote control and the pet will act accordingly.

- Basic functions: forward, Turn Left, Turn Right
- Action: swimming, sitting down, stunt, pushup, sleep, urinate, pick up, get down.
- Entertainment: Greetings, Kung Fu, dance music.

Trigger function introduction

Press the pick-up button on the remote control, and the robotic arm at the top opens up and places the card or small object you want to pick up. Press the remote control button again, you can clamp things. Press it again, and the clip opens.

Don't panic when you have a problem

COMMON PROBLEM	TREATMENT METHOD
It does not respond when turned on.	Please check that the battery is properly connected, or that the charge is sufficient.
The remote control cannot be controlled.	Make sure the remote is fully charged. The remote control should be aligned with the signal receiving port of the dog. In strong light or sunlight will affect the remote control operation.
The dog doesn't act on the control signals.	Please check if your dog's battery is full. Garbled characters will appear when the battery is low.
