"Check how many alarms I have"



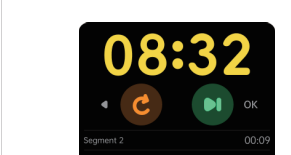
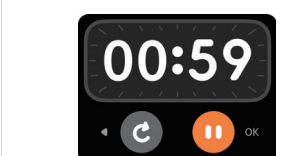
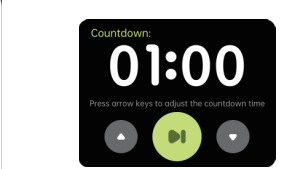

How do I network my devices
Start by opening [Settings] - [Wi-Fi] on your device.
Once in the network list, select a Wi-Fi and press the OK key to connect
The password must be entered using the arrow key and the OK key.
Attention:
(1) If you cannot find the WiFi name, check whether the router hides the WiFi.
(2) The product does not support 5G WiFi connection, and the 5G related network name will not be displayed on the WiFi list.
For iPhone 12 and later models, turn on the "Maximum Compatibility" option on the hotspot when connecting to the network.
Path: Mobile 【Settings】 - 【Personal hotspot】 - [Maximum compatibility].



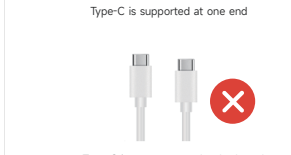
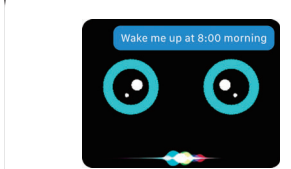

My alarm clock
Setting an alarm
Method 1: On the device, you can only add an alarm by voice control. For example:
"Hello Timi, set an alarm clock for 8:00 tomorrow morning."
Method 2: Binding with the mobile phone, you can add an alarm clock in the small program on the mobile phone.
Deleting an alarm
Mode 1: One the device, you can delete the alarm clock by voice control. For example: "Hello Timi, delete the alarm clock at 8:00 tomorrow morning"
Mode 2: After entering the alarm list on the device, press the left button to delete the alarm.
Mode 3: Delete via the parent applet
Edit alarm clock
Method 1: Modify by voice.
Example: "Hello Timi, tomorrow morning the alarm clock at 8:00 will be changed to 9:00."
Method 2: Modify through the parent program
Alarm response
When the alarm time is reached, the device will automatically ring, now Press the OK button for snooze mode. It will ring again in five minutes; Hold down the OK key to disable the alarm.

Tomato alarm clock
Set tomato alarm
Mode 1: The default Tomato clock time is 25 minutes, Can pass the device in the direction, Down key, Select the usual tomato time;
Mode 2: Set a custom tomato time through the parent applet.
Tomato bell open
After setting the tomato time, Press OK Just start, During the operation of the Tomato-bell, the default background music can also be used Arrow keys Combine the OK key Turn off the background music on the left, press the OK button to pause the Tomato-clock, and press the button on the right to stop the Tomato-clock. Before stopping the Tomato-clock, there will be a confirmation pop-up window requiring the user to confirm;
End Tomato clock
At the end of the Tomato-clock, there will be a short 5-minute break(Default short rest duration, can be set in the applet) After 4 rounds, or get a long rest.

Countdown:
Set countdown time
Mode1: The default value is 1 minute. You can adjust the countdown time by pressing the up and down keys. The unit of each adjustment is 1 minute Press the OK key to start;
Mode2: voice-controlled, Give an example: "Hello Timi, count down three minutes."
End countdown
Double click back Countdown can exit.

Second watch
After entering the application, press the "OK" key to start timing;
Pause: After starting the timing, press OK again to pause the timing;
reset: After suspending the timing, press the left button to reset the timing directly;
section: When the time is being timed, press the left key to record the current time, which is convenient for segmented recording.

Voice assistant
Wake mode
Mode1: Press and hold the voice button on your device
Mode2: wakeword "Hello Timi" Wake up immediately
Mode3: Press OK from the voice assistant icon on the home screen
After waking up, you can speak the command to the device
Give an example:
"Set my alarm for 9:00 tomorrow morning."
"Full volume"
"Brightness set to minimum"
"Turn on XX function"
"Time me."
"..."
