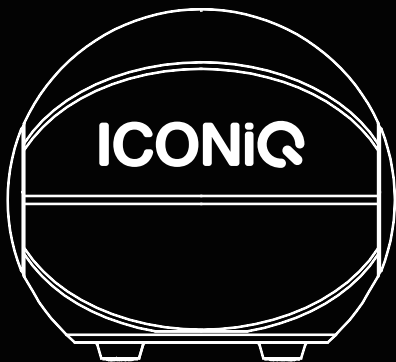

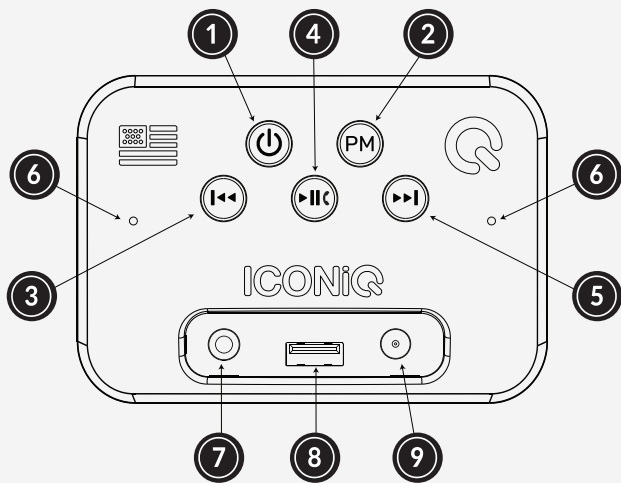

SAFETY MANUAL

- Please strictly refer to all warning tips and usage guidelines.
- This product is strictly prohibited from being used near flowing, splashing and dripping liquids. Please keep all liquids away from this product.
- Do not use this product in wet environment or near water. Please use dry or slightly wet cloth to clean this product.
- Do not put this product in a wet environment.
- Do not allow product to be used by children.
- Do not cover this product with tablecloths or curtains. Please use this product in a well-ventilated environment.
- Do not put the product near fire, such as candles or other extreme sources of light.
- Please press buttons gently to prevent damage.
- Do not use this product in an excessively dry environment to prevent electrostatic damage to the product.
- Do not use this product in an environment above 35°C/95°F degrees, and please avoid direct sunlight.

INSTRUCTIONS

POWER SWITCH

- Press and hold the power button for 3 to 4 seconds to finish the startup after hearing the startup prompt tone.
- Press and hold the power button for 3 to 4 seconds to turn it off.

VOLUME DOWN/LAST SONG

- In the process of playing music, long press to reduce the volume.
- In the process of playing music, short press to jump to the last song.
- At the same time, you can also control the volume on smart devices or playback devices.

PLAY/PAUSE/BLUETOOTH CONNECTION

- Play: Short press to play or pause music.

BLUETOOTH PAIRING

1. Press and hold TWS for 1S to enter the Bluetooth pairing state.
2. The blue LED blinks, waiting for the direct Bluetooth connection to succeed.
3. The blue light stays on after the Bluetooth connection is successful. If the product is not connected to the phone, it will automatically shut down after 10 minutes without any operation
4. Please follow your Bluetooth device instructions to connect Bluetooth to this product.
5. Use your devices to search and select the Bluetooth name: ICONIQ to pair and connect.
6. After a successful Bluetooth connection, the blue light is on and a successful connection tone can be heard.

AUDIO INPUT

- This product has audio input function and can be connected to most playback devices through a 3.5mm audio cable. It is suitable for audio playback devices without Bluetooth function.

INSTRUCTIONS

ANSWER THE PHONE

1. When Bluetooth is connected, if there is a call, press the play button briefly to answer the call.
2. Press the play button briefly again to hang up the phone during the call.
3. Press and hold the play button to reject the call.
4. Please keep within 30 meters of the microphone to ensure the quality of the call.

VOLUME UP/NEXT SONG

1. In the process of playing music, press and hold to increase the volume.
2. In the process of playing music, short press to jump to the next song. At the same time, you can also control the volume on smart devices or playback devices.

EXTERNAL CHARGING

1. Plug the charging line into the USB interface, and the other end of the charging line is connected to the mobile backup to be recharged.
2. In order to ensure the best sound quality, please try not to play music while charging.

CHARGING

1. Plug the Type-C charging line into the Type-C charging interface on the back of the product, and connect the other end to a 5V1A charger or other 5V1A external charging devices.
2. It takes 3 to 5 hours to complete a full charge. (It depends on the charger)
3. During the charging process, the red light of the charging indicator is on, and when it is full, the red light goes out.
4. In order to ensure the best sound quality, please make sure that the product has sufficient power.

INSTRUCTIONS

LIGHTING EFFECTS SWITCHING

- Click the power button to cycle through the 8 lighting effects including the light off effect.

TWS FUNCTION

1. Prepare two or more products of the same series, and turn them on separately.
2. Double-click TWS key of one product to enter TWS mode as the main machine. Double-click TWS key of other products again to exit TWS mode.
3. Double-click TWS key of other products to enter TWS mode as the auxiliary machine, and wait for the main/auxiliary machine to connect automatically. The connection is successful after hearing the tone.

SPECIAL REMINDER

1. After entering TWS mode, the APP will be temporarily unavailable.
2. After entering TWS mode, only the main machine can answer the phone calls, and the auxiliary machine is silent.
3. After entering TWS mode, close one of the products, while the other will be automatically turned off.
4. After entering TWS mode, only the main machine can control the volume, play, pause and control the light effect, and the auxiliary machine can only control the power off.
5. To exit TWS mode, please double-click TWS button again.
6. To disconnect the main and auxiliary machines, please double-click the TWS button of the main machine or the TWS button of auxiliary machine again.
7. After the main and auxiliary machines are successfully connected to TWS, they will be automatically connected the next time they enter TWS, only for the two products that have been successfully connected.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
Bluetooth cannot pair or connect.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check to see if power is on• Check to see if unit is paired to other devices• Initiate a reboot and repeat the pairing operation
There is noise when playing music.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check to see if this product and playback device are compatible.• Check distance between product and playback device• Check for shielding object or magnetic field• Check to see if product has sufficient power.• If battery is low, charge before use.
