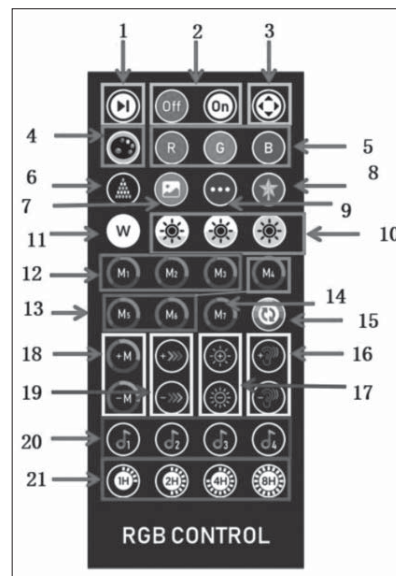


2.3 Remote Control Functions



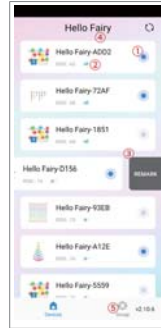
Hello Fairy APP Custom DIY

1. Pause/Play button.
2. On and Off button.
3. Light string pattern transformation modes: move up, move down, move left, move right, blink, fixed.
4. Color palette, tap to switch colors.
5. Single LED color button for quick switching between red, green, and blue modes.
6. Cycle through fixed scene modes.
7. Cycle through graphic scene modes.
8. Tree-top star control button, cycling through fixed warm light, scene follow, and off.
9. Toggle between text display or customizable.
10. Brightness button: from left to right, 25%, 50%, 100%.
11. Cool white and warm white button.
12. Switch between three fixed scene modes.
13. Switch between three graphic scene modes.
14. Text scene mode or customizable.
15. Cycle through individual theme scene modes, switching every 30 seconds.
16. Sensitivity adjustment buttons for music mode.
17. LED brightness adjustment buttons (increase/decrease).
18. Switch between individual scene mode and music mode, next and previous.
19. Scene mode speed adjustment (increase/decrease).
20. Four music modes.
21. Timer function: 1 hour, 2 hours, 4 hours, 8 hours.

Special note: The help document is only used to help users quickly understand and use the APP proficiently, and is not used as a basis for any specific product functions.

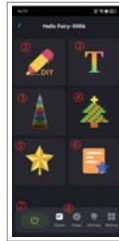
I Home Page



- (1) Switch status of the string of lights: the blue dot indicates the better the signal/light is on;
- (2) RSSI Bluetooth signal strength: the closer the value to 0, the light is on;
- (3) Note: Slide the equipment from left to right to change the equipment note name;
- (4) Drop-down refresh: New devices can be discovered by drop-down refresh;
- (5) Groups: Create Groups with Group Control Devices here (Click to view the introduction of group features [Group function--APPInstructions](#)).

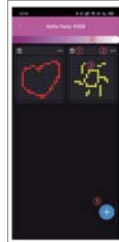

- 1.Remove: Remove the effect
 - 2.Enter the details page.
 - 3.DIY preview
 - 4.Brightness
 - 5.Add DIY: Up to 30 effects can be added

2.2.1 Single Frame DIY



- Single frame DIY and multi-frame DIY switch: left for "single frame", right for "multi-frame" (can be selected when creating DIY)
- 2.Point Formation Preview Area: Tap into the "DIY Drawing Page"
 - 3.Direction of movement: Can be set: right, left, down, up, flashing, fixed
 - 4.Speed regulation and suspension



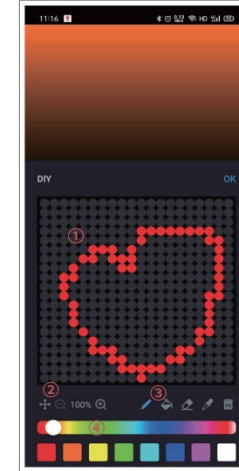
They are: right, left, down, up, flashing, static, several light movement modes



They are: up, down, left, right, flashing, static, Up circulation, down circulation, left circulation, right circulation, breathing, several light movement modes

Warm reminder: Different product types or different device firmware versions support different DIY movement directions/modes. Please refer to the actual display on the app interface. The above is only an explanation of the app interface.

- Single Frame DIY Painting Page**
- 1.Canvas: A "dot" represents a lamp bead (for reference only, depending on the "DIY canvas" that each device sees when connected to the app)

- Multi Frame DIY Painting Page**

2.2.3 Text effects



- Text Effects List Page**
1. The brightness
 - 2.Click "Text Content" to select the effect;
 - 3.Click "Enter" to edit the effect
 - 4.Delete custom text effects (the top 6 are preset text effects, which can be modified and not deleted);
 - 5.Added Text Effects



- Text Effects Detail Page**
1. Text content display box, click to enter the edit text mode;
 2. The text color switch. If turned on, the text color uses the currently selected "text color" or "gradient"; if the switch is turned off, the text color is displayed as "the color set by the user when entering text."
 3. Text color bars and text gradients
 4. Background color switch and background color bar;
 5. The direction of the text flow: right, left, down, up, flashing, fixed (where "fixed" and "flashing" mode, when the screen display is not finished, it will automatically switch the content of the next screen);
 6. Speed and suspension;

- Text Input Page**
- Text input: only support English and Arabic numerals input, the maximum input 40 characters, such as the need to delete part of the text, please use the "backspace" on the keyboard
- 2 The color of the text: the color of the input text is initially displayed according to the color picker positioned at the time of input;
- Warm Tips:
- Try to avoid typing or deleting text too fast, if the deletion speed is too fast or flash by moving the cursor to the middle to delete, it may cause theapp to crash;
 - Please avoid typing letters or numbers.

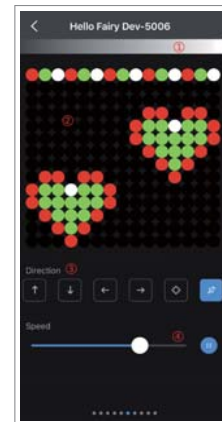
2.3 Preset effect

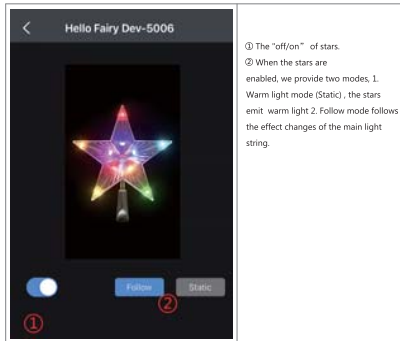
2.4 Preset (pixel art) effect



- Preset (Btmeg) effect page**
- ① The brightness of the scene;
 - ② Preset dot plot effect: can slide around switch;
 - ③ Movement: single frame dot map effect can set the direction of movement, multi-frame dot map effect can not set the direction. The direction of a single frame can be set: upward, downward, left, right flow, or flashing and static;
 - ③ Adjust speed and pause;

2.5 Tree-top star effect



- ① The "off/on" of stars.
- ② When the stars are enabled, we provide two modes. 1. Warm light mode (Static), the stars emit warm light. 2. Follow mode follows the effect changes of the main light string.

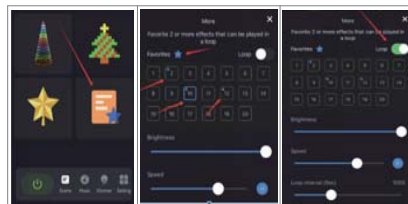
2.6 More Effects & Collections & Loops

First of all, please make sure to enter the scene page of your device and find the entry icon of the Favorites and Loop function, if there is no such entry then it means that your device may not support Favorites and Loop. If after entering the Favorites and Loop interface, the interface does not show the "Switch of Loop" then it means that the current firmware version of your device may not support Loop.

Proceed as follows:

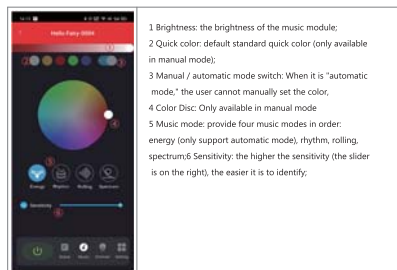
- Step 1: Find the "Scene Favorites and Loop" function entrance icon on the scene page, click to enter the Favorites loop and loop setting page.
- Step 2: Click the scene number, the effect you like, and then click the " " icon to collect it.
- Step 3: If the number of Favorites is greater than or equal to 2, the cycle switch can be turned on, as shown in the diagram below.

The effect serial numbers in the above picture are only examples. The specific number is subject to the actual number of serial numbers seen.

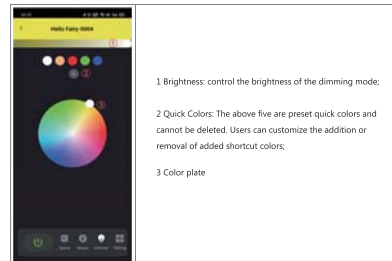
III. Musical Rhythms



- 1 Brightness: the brightness of the music module;
- 2 Quick color: default standard quick color (only available in manual mode);
- 3 Manual / automatic mode switch: When it is "automatic mode," the user cannot manually set the color;
- 4 Color Disc: Only available in manual mode;
- 5 Music Mode: provide four music modes in order: energy (only support automatic mode), rhythm, rolling, spectrum. Sensitivity: the higher the sensitivity (the slider is on the right), the easier it is to identify;

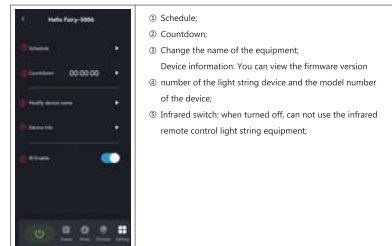

IV. Dimming effect



- 1 Brightness: control the brightness of the dimming mode;
- 2 Quick Colors: The above five are preset quick colors and cannot be deleted. Users can customize the addition or removal of added shortcut colors;
- 3 Color plate

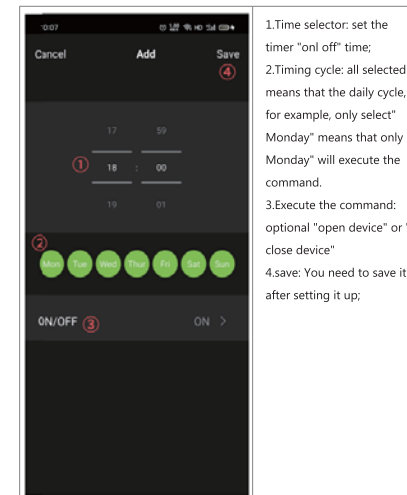
V. SETTING UP



- ① Schedule;

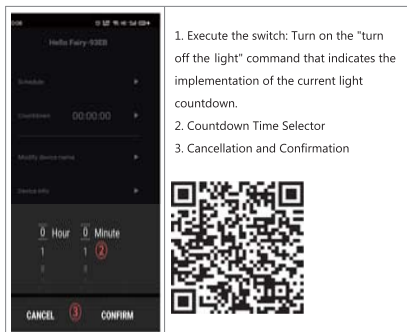

1. Time selector: set the timer "on/off" time;
2. Timing cycle: all selected means that the daily cycle, for example, only select "Monday" means that only "Monday" will execute the command.
3. Execute the command: optional "open device" or "close device"
