

Connection and function instructions:



Push the switch to the corresponding position of "on", then the speaker turns on and enters the Bluetooth mode.

Bluetooth

1. Open the speaker and enter Bluetooth mode to perform Bluetooth pairing.
2. Open the need to connect the speaker to play music mobile phone or computer, TV, all-in-one and other sound source equipment. Set the menu, turn on the Bluetooth switch and search for Bluetooth devices.
3. In the search device list, click the corresponding model and connect. After the connection is successful, the connection prompt will ring Tone pairing is successful.
4. Use audio source devices to play music (turn the volume to the minimum before playing).
5. the speaker will have a memory function, and after the successful connection with the sound source device, there is no need to pair again .when the next use. If the rollback fails, the system automatically switches to the pairing state.
6. If you want to replace the sound source device, you need to follow the above steps to reconnect the pair

FM

After the speaker is turned on, press the "M", press the prompt tone to enter the FM mode, long press the pause key to search channels of FM, up and down song to switch channel of FM.

USB/TF Card USB TF

Insert the USB device or TF card containing music into the corresponding card slot of the speaker, and then automatically play the music of the corresponding interface device.

Line in-AUX AUX

Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio input cable to the "AUX" and the other end to the audio output interface of the audio source player device, enter the "AUX" audio input.

Coaxial COAX





Insert one end of the coaxial cable to the "COAX" of the speaker and the other end to the coaxial output interface of the audio source playback device, enter the coaxial mode.

Charge DC-5V

1. Use the TYPE C USB cable to a standard USB charger for charging.
2. Recommended that this product be charged every three months if not in use.













