User Manual

- 1. Ensure the product is fully charged before use.
- 2. Some products have insulation stickers at the end of the earbuds; please remove them before use.
- 3. The product only supports charging with a USB cable. If it doesn't charge,

try using another cable. (Recommended power: 3.7V/5V)

- If one earbud is not working properly, disconnect and reconnect. Make sure both earbuds are charged and then take them out of the charging case to re-pair.
