Thank you for purchasing our bedding dryer. This manual contains safety precautions, product cleaning, maintenance, inspection tips, and instructions for use. Please read carefully and use the product safely. Keep this manual for future reference.

XI. Q&A

Q: Is the bedding dryer energy efficient?

A: The bedding dryer adopts high-efficiency motor and intelligent temperature control system, which is more energy-saving. However, the specific power consumption will vary depending on the model and frequency of use.

Q: How to ensure better drying results?

A: Place the bedding evenly and keep it loose, avoid overlapping and pressing. At the same time, make sure there is proper air circulation space between the bedding.

Q: How long can the bedding dryer run continuously?

A: Our bedding dryer can be timed and you can choose between 5 to 180 minutes. It is recommended to set the time as needed to avoid long continuous operation to prolong the life of the machine.

Q: Does the bedding dryer damage the material of the bedding?

A: Bedding dryers will not damage most materials if used according to the manufacturer's recommendations. It is recommended to use the low temperature mode for delicate materials.

Q: How long can the bedding dryer run continuously?

A: Our bedding dryer can be timed and you can choose between 5 to 180 minutes. It is recommended to set the time as needed to avoid long continuous operation to prolong the life of the machine.

Q: Is it normal for the dryer to have a burning smell sometimes during operation?

A: Not normal. The burning smell may be due to overheating or foreign matter inside. You should stop using it immediately and contact the after-sales service.

Q: How long can the machine run continuously?

A: It is recommended to run continuously for no more than 2 hours at a time to avoid long time use affecting the life of the machine.

I. Bedding dryer after-sales service instructions

Warranty coverage:

1. The problem of quality under normal use of this product, such as motor failure, abnormal heating function, etc., are within the warranty.
2. Due to non-human damage caused by parts failure, such as heating elements, circuit boards, display, etc., are entitled to free replacement service.

Not under warranty:

1. Failure caused by improper use, unauthorized disassembly, repair or modification of the product.
2. Damage caused by external factors such as fall and impact, liquid infiltration, etc.
3. Damage caused by natural disasters (such as lightning, earthquake, fire, etc.) or other force majeure factors.
4. Products that exceed the warranty period.

X. Usage instructions

- *When the set time runs out, the screen counts down 10 seconds, then displays "OFF" and stops operation.
- *If you want to stop the machine during operation, press the "STOP" button, the screen will count down 10 seconds, then display "OFF" and the machine will stop running.

4. Storing after use

1. Hold the power plug and unplug it from the socket.
2. Remove the hose after the main unit cools down and store it.
3. Use velcro strap to bundle the power cord for storage.



Note :

Do not force the power cord into the outlet, as it may cause a fire if the cord breaks.

Closets and closets

Open the door and operate with the air vents facing inwards and the temperature set to 40°C.

Caution:

*Do not place the dryer body in a closet or drawer.

*Make sure that drawers and closets are in open form to allow free access to take out and put in items.



Under sink or washbasin

Operating temperature is 40°C with the door open and the air vents facing you.

Caution:

*When using 65°C or 40°C, make sure that the material and heat-resistant temperature of the part of the object to be dried that is exposed to the warm air is higher than the warm air temperature before using it.

*Use the "warm air" when drying items with a lower heat-resistant temperature.

II. Safety precautions:

Must know!!

● Enforcement

The plug

*Insert the plug firmly into the electric socket.

Hold the plug to pull it out.

*Pulling on the power cord may damage it, resulting in electric shock or a short circuit.

Remove the plug after using the product.

*After using the product, unplug it from the power source, otherwise it may cause injury, burns or fire and electric shock due to the insulation falling off.

● Prohibited

Do not use damaged power cord, plug or loose socket.

* Short-circuiting may cause fire or electric shock.

Do not bundle power cord and energize them.

* Excessive heat may cause burns or fire. Be sure to use the power cord fully uncoiled.

● Power-off operation

When cleaning, checking or moving the equipment, be sure to remove the plug from the outlet before cleaning, checking or moving the product.

- *Always set the appliance to "Warm Air" and select the lowest temperature (the first indicator light on the thermostat comes on).
- *When the set time runs out, the screen counts down 10 seconds, then displays "OFF" and stops operation.
- *If you want to stop the machine during operation, press the "STOP" button, the screen will count down 10 seconds, then display "OFF" and the machine stops running.

4. Storing after use

1. Hold the power plug and unplug it from the socket.



1. Extend the hose and insert the nozzle (air outlet) into the shoes.



*It is also possible to dry two pairs of shoes at the same time.



*When drying shoes with laces, be careful not to let the laces get sucked into the air vents.

Tips to make shoes dry quickly

*Wiping water off wet shoes first with a dry cloth will make the dryer take less time to dry shoes.


*When drying shoes with laces, loosen the knot of the laces first, and put the laces into the shoes to prevent the laces from being sucked into the air inlet and outlet.

II. Safety precautions:


Do not dry dripping laundry.

*Failure to do so may result in electric shock.



Do not use on items with low heat-resistant temperature (e.g. leather, synthetic leather sofas, etc.).

*Failure to do so may result in deformation or deterioration.



Leather shoes (including synthetic leather), clothes with low heat resistance, bleach-soaked clothes, or clothes that need to be laid flat to dry.

Do not use high temperature air for drying.

*Be sure to use the warm air mode and adjust the temperature to the lowest (room temperature) setting.

Do not use against a window or mirror.

*Sharp changes in temperature difference may cause breakage.

Using instructions

This bedding dryer is intended for home use only. Do not use it for any purpose except for drying bedding, using accessories or for professional use.

X. Usage instructions

* Start operation: Press the Start button to start the unit, the remaining time will be displayed on the operation panel and a “hissing” sound will be emitted.

Caution:

In this state, the default mode is “Summer” mode.


When the set time is reached, the remaining time on the display will gradually decrease. The screen will count down for about 10 seconds, then “OFF” will be displayed and the screen will turn off.

- * When drying heavier bedding, lift the bedding slightly so that the warm air can reach downward.
- * If you feel that the side opposite to that on which the hose is inserted (e.g. the foot side) is not drying enough, insert the hose on that side and try again.
- * If the four corners of the mattress are not warm enough, move the hose and try again.
- * If you want to stop the machine, press the “Stop” button, the screen will count down for about 10 seconds, and then “OFF” will be displayed to stop the machine.

After using the product to remove mites, it is recommended to use the bedding vacuum cleaner to suck away the dead mites.

5. Storing after use

1. Hold the power plug and unplug it from the socket.



2. Remove the hose after the main unit cools down and store it.

This product is an unpadded bedding dryer and is not supplied with a cushion.

X. Usage instructions

1. Stretch the hose and place the unit control panel facing upwards


*Please assemble the main unit and hose in the following order.

When placing this product from the cover head

*Place this product with the control panel facing upward at the head of the cover.

*When using dual hoses at the same time, you can choose to assemble the two hoses to different lengths.

*When using both hoses at the same time, place both mouthpieces into the comforter even if you are only drying one comforter.




When placing the product from the side of the comforter

*Place the product from the side of the comforter with the control panel facing up.

*When using two tubes at the same time, you can choose to place one tube at the head of the comforter and one at the tail of the comforter.

*Extend the hose so that the mouthpiece is as close as possible to the center of the comforter.

(Do not block the suction port on the side of the main unit.)



V. Description of accessories and functions

Wireless remote control



1. 5mins, start the timer of the machine for 5mins .
2. 15mins, start the timer of the machine for 15mins.
3. 60mins, start the timer of the machine for 60mins.
4. 120mins, start the timer of the machine for 120mins.
5. Cooling down, lower the temperature by one degree.
6. Heating up, raise the temperature level by one degree.
7. Turn off the device remotely.
8. Turn on the machine remotely.




2. Storage method

After stopping the machine, unplug it from the power supply, store the hose and nozzle in the main unit, and store the power cord with the velcro strap.

- Hose and nozzle

1. Shorten the hose by about 35cm.



- Power Cord

Equipped with a velcro strap to easily store the power cord.



VI. Product temperature control instructions

Notes

- *Please press the "Warm" button once and then the "Start" button when you want to activate the constant temperature.
- *If the "Start" button is not pressed, the constant temperature will not start.
- *In addition, if you want to cancel the constant temperature mode after pressing the "Warm" button, you can double-click the "Warm" button to release the constant temperature.

Q:What is the effect of using the machine in summer or humid weather?

A: Using the bedding dryer in humid weather can keep the bedding dry, especially in the rainy season or high humidity summer, the use of the effect is particularly significant.

XII. Maintenance instructions

① Caution

After using the machine, it will become very hot, so please wipe or clean it after it has cooled down sufficiently.

1. When cleaning the body, please fully wring out the rag with water and then wipe the dirt.
2. Clean the dust from the power plug regularly.
3. Be sure to remove the power plug from the socket before cleaning.
4. Do not rinse the body with water or immerse it in liquid.
5. A clogged or dirty filter (air inlet) can easily lead to a decrease in drying performance, resulting in overheating or malfunctioning of the machine, so it is recommended to clean it with a vacuum cleaner once a month at regular intervals.

Dry the water and operate in the "Warm Air" mode.

Drying Pet Hair

Before using the dryer, use an absorbent towel to wipe away any moisture from your pet's body before using the dryer to dry its coat.

- Do not put the air vents directly into your pet's ears. If water gets into your dog's ears, gently wipe it away with a paper towel or gauze.
- Keep a distance of about 30 centimeters from your pet's face to prevent the hot air from blowing directly into your pet's face.
- Observe the situation and adjust the temperature at any time to avoid burdening the pet and owner.



XI. Q&A

Q: What is the main function of the bedding dryer?

A: The main function of the bedding dryer is to remove moisture and humidity from the bedding by means of a warm airflow, keeping the bedding dry, warm and comfortable and preventing the growth of mold and bacteria.

Q: What types of bedding are bedding dryers suitable for?

A: Bedding dryers are usually suitable for bedding made of cotton, synthetic fibers, feather and wool. Please check the wash label or manufacturer's instructions before using the dryer.

Q: What should I be aware of when using a bedding dryer?

A: Do not cover the body of the bedding dryer with bedding or block the air intake; make sure the dryer is well ventilated. Avoid using the dryer in humid environments and clean the machine's filter regularly.

II. Safety precautions:

Must know!!

● Enforcement

If an abnormality occurs, stop using the product immediately, disconnect the power supply, and remove the plug from the power socket to avoid smoke, fire, and electric shock.

(Abnormal conditions)

- * Burning smell, strange noise in motion.
- * Plug and power cord are abnormally hot.
- * The power supply is intermittent when the power cord is moved.
- * The power supply stops from time to time during operation.
- * Tingling sensation when touching.

Please stop using the product immediately and consult with the store where you purchased it or the after-sales service center.



* Do not place the dryer directly under the clothes to be dried. If water drops get inside the dryer, it may cause electric shock or short circuit.

* When adjusting the outlet angle, tilt the root of the hose tip.



2. Insert the power plug: Insert the power plug into the socket and the appliance will enter standby mode.



3. Selecting the operation mode.

Select the temperature and running time according to the clothes.



*【Precautions for drying down comforter】


When drying the down comforter, be careful that the temperature is not too high to avoid damaging the feathers. High temperatures may damage the fluffiness and warmth of the down, and may also cause odors or fires. You are advised to set the drying temperature to the lowest possible setting to ensure the safety and performance of your duvet.

Usage instructions

• Freedom to use

1. Unfold the hose and place the nozzle as close to the bedding as possible.
2. Place the bedding flat on the hose and press down on both sides of the hose to prevent warm air from leaking between the hose and the bedding.
3. Insert the power plug firmly into the wall socket, and the unit will automatically enter the last set operation mode after the power is turned on.
4. Press the Mode button to switch the automatic operation mode “removal mites → warm air → summer → winter” in sequence.
5. Press the start button to start running, the machine will emit a “nuisance” sound and the remaining time will be displayed on the operation panel.

IV. Functional description of the operating panel



1. Setting the timer, press the button again will switch to the next timer in order, there are a total of nine timers, respectively 5-15-30-45-60-75-90-120-180 minutes.
2. Cooling down, lower the temperature by one degree.
3. Stop, press the button will enter the 10s countdown, the end of the countdown will turn off the device, press other buttons during the countdown will not stop the countdown to shutdown.
4. Warm, according to the current room temperature automatically adjust the temperature gear.
5. Start, will cancel the "stop" button countdown and turn on the device again.
6. Heating up, raise the temperature level by one degree.
7. Mode, switch four automatic operation modes: "mite removal", "summer", "warm air", "winter".
8. Temperature light, display the current temperature level, in order of the first "green light", second "orange light", third "orange-red light", fourth "Red light".
9. Mode indicators, from left to right are: "Mite Removal", "Summer", "Warm Air", "Winter".
10. Countdown screen, displaying the countdown time of the current execution.
11. Temperature level light, using different colors to show different temperature levels: first "green light", second "orange light", third "orange light", fourth "red light".
12. Constant temperature light, to show whether the constant temperature is now on or not.

X. Usage instructions

2. Dry beddings:

- *Place the hose outside the comforter as far as possible.
- *Press the hose firmly to prevent air from escaping through the gap between the hose and the bedding.

Caution:

- *Do not cover the body of the product with bedding or block the air intake.
- *Drying is not possible using only the mattress (lower comforter). Be sure to cover the comforter (top quilt) with the hose.
- *The overlapping part of the mattress and comforter may not dry sufficiently.

Improving drying efficiency

- *Please stretch the warm air hose and open the folded wing at the end of the hose.



- *By creating some space between the bedding, the hot air can be distributed more evenly.

3. Insert the power plug: Insert the power plug into the socket and the appliance will enter standby mode.



4. Select the operation mode:

(Select temperature mode and time setting as needed)

- *Temperature adjustment from left to right has 4 settings: room temperature, 40°C, 50°C and 65°C.



- *It can run for any of the 8 time settings of 15, 30, 45, 60, 75, 90, 120 or 180 minutes. The unit will stop automatically when the running time is over.




