Function Instructions

1 Turning on and off the machine

Turns on automatically when plugged in, as shown in (Picture 4) interface connection
Automatic shutdown after power disconnection.

2 Restart

Long press Reset for ten seconds in the beginning state, the machine will restart automatically.

3 USB interface

Insert the mouse to use when operating the application.
Support USB storage device.

4 TYPE_C interface

For the use of developers.
