# G050L User Manual

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#### 1 Matters needing attention

To keep you, your car and others safe, be sure to meet the following basic requirements:

- 1.1 You may use the various functions of this car audio only if the traffic permits.
- 1.2 During driving, please focus your attention first on driving.
- 1.3. During the use of the stereo, adjust the volume of the stereo to a level that does not prevent you from hearing outside sounds.
- 1.4. In order to prevent short circuit, please install and connect all the car audio, and then connect the electrode of the car battery.
- 1.5. Do not open the machine for maintenance, if you need maintenance, please go to the professional maintenance station for maintenance, otherwise, small

The failure causes a big problem and brings you unnecessary property damage.

- 1.6 When cleaning the car, do not let water droplets splash onto the machine.
- 1.7 Do not use the machine when the temperature is too high or too low; otherwise, the machine cannot run normally. If this happens, discontinue use until the temperature returns to normal.
- 1.8 Do not use sharp objects to scratch the display, do not use hard objects to vigorously press the display, otherwise it will cause damage to the display or touch screen.
- 1.9 After the product is scrapped, please dispose of it properly (for example, discard it in the trash can suitable for electronic products, so as not to pollute the environment) The main functions of the car include: USB music/video/picture, Bluetooth phone, Bluetooth music, reversing, air conditioning, mobile phone interconnection, rear view, calendar and other functions.




Click this button to switch between day and night modes





### 4 Bluetooth function operation

Clicking on the main interface will enter the Bluetooth operation interface


- Note: 1. There are differences in the Bluetooth modules and software used by different brands of mobile phones, and some phones are not compatible.
- 2. Third party mobile application software and mobile voice function are not fully compatible; 2 does not support answering and hanging up voice calls from third-party application software;
- 3. For driving safety, other functional operations are not allowed during calls.

#### **Pairing Connection Steps**

- 1.Set the Bluetooth switch on the host to the on state.
- 2. Turn on the Bluetooth function on the Bluetooth phone, and the Bluetooth phone will start searching for the Bluetooth device model. When the Bluetooth name of the host is displayed on the phone, click on the Bluetooth name, and a Bluetooth pairing request will appear. Click pairing, and once pairing is successful, the phone will automatically connect to the host.


### 5.1 Multimedia List and Audio Playback

### 5 Multimedia function operations

The multimedia function interface includes music function interface, video function interface, and image function interface.

- 1.The formats that can support audio playback include: MP3, WMA, OGG, WAV, AMR, APE, FLAC, M4A.
- 2.The formats that can support video playback include: MP4, MKV, ASF, 3GP, MPG, AVI, M4V, MOV, AVI, FLV, F4V, WMV, RMVB.
  - 3. The formats that can support image playback include BMP, JPEG, PNG, and GIF formats.
  - If the selected file cannot be played, it will automatically switch to the next playable file.

The platform cannot be compatible with all USB drives. Due to the different standards of different brands and manufacturers of USB drives, some USB drives may not be able to play.


### 6 Calendars

### 7 Mobile phone interconnection


Click

on the second page of the main interface to enter the air conditioning interface.


1. When there is a change in air conditioning information, it will automatically jump to the air conditioning interface.


2.If there is no operation in the air conditioning interface for 7S, it will automatically jump out of the air conditioning interface.




### 9.1 System Settings

Adjustable media volume, call volume, navigation volume, and button volume, with a range of 0-30




Synchronizing GPS time, selecting the corresponding region will synchronize the time of the corresponding region









Drag to adjust low/medium/high tones, ranging from -7 to 7

Drag the square to adjust the sound field, with the square centered by default






Click to return the block to its default position


