




SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

01. DO NOT immerse air purifier in water or liquids, as it may result in damage to the appliance.
02. DO NOT clean the appliance with water or any other liquid.
03. DO NOT plug the appliance if the plug, the power cord, the power adapter or the appliance itself is damaged.
04. Avoid hitting the Safee with hard objects.
05. This appliance should only be used in environments with temperatures between 14°F and 140°F (-10°C and 40°C).
06. DO NOT attempt to repair this device in any way or use any replacement components or parts to modify the Safee. Doing so will void your warranty. Contact customer service immediately if your appliance is no longer working.

PRODUCT INTRODUCTION



PRE-OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Safee magnetic mounting**

- Safee magnetically attaches to supported models (iPhone 12 models or later)
- For any other model, use the Magsafe Magnet Sticker included with Safee and attach it to the center of the back of your phone.
- Attach Safee to the back of your phone. Safee can also be used without being attached to the phone at an acceptable distance for a Bluetooth connection.

- **Safee mobile application installing**

- Make sure your Safee is charged.
- Download the Safee app onto your phone from the App Store or Google Play.
- Open the app and create an account by following the on-screen instructions.
- For Safee to work properly, you must accept access requests.

- **Bluetooth pairing**

- Open the app
- Make sure your phone's Bluetooth is activated.
- Switch on your Safee by pressing the button on the module once.
- Accept the pairing request with your Safee. (If it doesn't appear: press for at least 10s).
- From now on, Safee will automatically connect to your phone.

OPERATION

Alarm On/Off Button:

- Use this button to turn on or turn off the Safee alarm;
- **To turn on the alarm, press the button at least 3 times in succession (default value).**
- After the turned on, the buzzer sounds and an emergency notification is sent to your emergencies contacts registered;
- To start the recording and transmit your position and video stream, press the Safee notification that appears on your phone's screen. For greater responsiveness, use your phone's facial recognition unlock feature. (This works if your Safee is correctly configured, your Bluetooth is activated, and the Safee app is running in the background)
- **Press and hold this button for 3 seconds (default value) to shut down.**
- To stop the buzzer and the live stream press the stop button on your phone's display.
- To save the recording on your phone press the save button on your phone's display.

FEATURES

- **Add Emergency Contact**
 - In the Safee application, select the 2nd tab of the app
 - Select "Add Emergency Contact"
 - Fill in the required information
 - Confirm by selecting "Create this contact"
 - Your contact will then have to install the application and create an account to receive your alerts and live stream.
- **Start a Safe Journey**
 - In the Safee application, go to the main tab (1st tab), enter the destination address in the search bar at the top of your screen.
 - Confirm by selecting "Start your journey"
 - Select emergency contacts who can view your journey and position, press confirm button.
 - Stop your journey by selecting stop button.

- **View/Download Recordings**

- In the Safee application, select the 3rd tab of the app
- Select the recording you wish to view
- To download the recording press download button
- Your contact will then have to install the application and create an account to receive your alerts and live stream.

- **Screen Lock Mode**

- If this mode is turn on, your phone's screen won't lock.
- In the Safee application, go to the main tab (1st tab), slide the left cursor to activate/deactivate the mode.

- **Silent Mode**

- If this mode is turn on, the buzzer will not sound when the alarm button is triggered
- Make sure your Safee is charged.
- Make sure your phone's Bluetooth is activated.
- Switch on the module by pressing the module button once.
- In the Safee application, go to the main tab (1st tab), slide the right cursor to activate/deactivate the mode.

• **Buzzer Settings**

- Make sure your Safee is charged.
- Make sure your phone's Bluetooth is activated.
- Switch on the module by pressing the module button once.
- In the Safee application, go to settings (4th tab) and select "setup my device"
- You can modify the number of presses to start an alert, the duration of the press to stop it, and the siren tone and speed.

• **Battery Level Display**

- Make sure your Safee is charged.
- Make sure your phone's Bluetooth is activated.
- Switch on the module by pressing the module button once.
- In the Safee application, go to the main tab (1st tab), the battery level is displayed at the top of your screen.
- If the charge level does not appear, Safee has run out of battery power or the Bluetooth connection has not been established correctly.

BATTERY RECHARGE

- Connect the USB-C cable to USB C plug.
- Connect the USB-C charging cable to a USB power adapter and plug it into a mains socket. You can also connect the charging cable to a USB port. When Safee recharges, LED lights up.
- Wait until your Safee is fully charged. LED goes out when Safee is fully charged.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Before cleaning, unplug the cable.
- You can use a soft, clean damp cloth to wipe the surface of the Safee.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Cause	Solution
The Bluetooth pairing doesn't work	Bluetooth pairing was not done correctly.	Close the Safee app completely. Charge your device (the LED will light up if charging successfully). Press the alarm button for at least 10s. Reopen your app. Accept the pairing request.
	The battery is completely discharged	Charge your device (the LED lights up if charging successfully)
Paired a new phone	You want to use Safee with a different phone.	Make sure your Safee is charged. Press the alarm button for at least 10s. Follow the pre operating instructions (p.6)

Problem	Cause	Solution
The charging LED does not light up when the USB C cable is plugged in	The cable is not properly plugged in	Check that the cable is plugged in properly
	The cable and/or adapter is defective	Change Cable and/or Adapter
	The device is defective	Contact our customer service
