To aid equipment authorization in other countries which accept the United States FCC Grant for Certification, Quanzhou Maycal Electronics Technology Co., Ltd. is requesting that the FCC lists the frequencies 400-470MHz under FCC Rule Parts 90 on the FCC Grant.

Quanzhou Maycal Electronics Technology Co., Ltd. attests that the Two Way Radio, will not be marketed to USA users with the frequency band which is not allowed by the rule part 90. Per the FCC's KDB634817 guidance, as an alternative to listing the exact frequencies, we acknowledge that it's a violation of the FCC Rules if this device operates on unauthorized frequencies.



Also, equipment programming is the responsibility of Authorized Service Personnel, the Two Way Radio is complies with 47 CFR Part 90.203(e), in that the operator cannot directly program the transmit frequencies using the normally accessible external controls.
