
# Optical Connection


Step 1: Removing the Protective Caps from both ends of the optical cable

Step3: Switching Soundbar to Optical Mode Press M button on top of soundbar or MODE button on remote to switch to OPT







# HDMI-ARC Connection

(Only for DS6401 series, DS6302 series, DS6541 series, and DS6741 series)



Step 1: Powering on the TV and turning on the source detection in TV setting

Step 2: Turning on HDMI-CEC/HDMI Devices Control on TV Settings






# Bluetooth Connection


Please make sure that your audio source devices are built with Bluetooth transmitter/output like smartphones, TVs and PCs, rather than a Bluetooth receiver/input like Bluetooth headphones, record players with speakers and Bluetooth speakers etc.

## Step 1: Switching the Soundbar to Bluetooth Mode


Pressing M button on top of soundbar or BT button on remote to switch to BT mode.


## Step 3: Indicator Light Instructions

The blue light blinks quickly means bluetooth is ready for connection;


The blue light blinks slowly means bluetooth is connected while no audio is being played.

## Step 5: Disconnect Bluetooth Quickly

If you want to connect another Bluetooth device, please press and hold MODE button or M button on soundbar for one second to disconnect bluetooth from the current device.


## Step 2: Connecting Devices via Bluetooth

## Step 4: If Audio and Video Out of Sync

If the audio is not synchronized with the video in Bluetooth connection mode, you can try adjusting the audio output delay in your TV settings. (Depends on your TV)




## Step 6: Please max the volume of TV or other audio sources, and then adjust the volume of soundbar

Pressing M button on top of soundbar or MODE button on remote to switch to AUX mode.








# Coaxial Connection



# Control remote functions or modes

1. Please connect the speaker with electricity, put the battery into the remote control, put the transmit port of the remote control directly opposite to the receiver port, then make the remote operation.
2. The remote control can be used up to approximately 6 meters, more than 6 meters will be invalid.
3. If the remote control with sundry, will not work properly.
4. In a strong interference signals, For example, Strong power, high frequency signal interference may affect remote control.
5. If you don't use remote control for a long time, please put the remote control without the battery.

Put the USB disk, auto switch to music mode.

## Bluetooth Mode

Put the USB disk, led display shows BLUE. Searching the Bluetooth device AB9 on your phone.

This machine uses V5.0+EDR Bluetooth specification.

Open transmission distance is 10 meter, Only the transmission audio.

# Frequently asked questions

## Trouble Shooting

Please check the following guide for the possible cause and solution for a problem before contacting the service centre or dealer for repairs:

### No sound

1. Check to make sure that the power connection is secure.
2. Check to make sure that the Audio supply equipment has been turned on

## Notes

During any connection steps, please make sure the power is OFF and don't turn on the power of Audio supply equipment. Make sure the connection is in correct way to prevent the plug become loosened and impact the timbre performance.

## Safety Instructions

### NOTES:

1. Please install the appliance in a dry and cleaning place, keep avoid in a dusty, damp or direct sunlight place.
2. When moving this appliance, please pull out the power plug and disconnect other equipment wires.
3. To prevent damage to the appliance, please keep the place ventilated.
