Selfie Stick User Manual

Product introduction

Please read this instruction manual carefully before using the product and keep it properly.

Packing list

Unfold the tripod and phone holder

1. Pull out the telescopic rod through the support foot at the bottom of the selfie stick.
2. Hold the telescopic rod and push the selfie stick vertically against the ground or table to support the tripod.
3. The tripod is manually deployed.
4. The phone holder can be rotated 90° left and right to achieve horizontal and vertical screen shooting of the phone.

Fix the phone

Open the phone clamp, place the phone close to the phone clamp (be careful to avoid the phone buttons), and clamp it. The phone clamp is suitable for phones with a width of 70-85mm.

Retract the phone clamp and tripod

1. Remove the phone from the phone clamp. 2. Hold the metal ring of the selfie stick. 3. Quickly push the telescopic rod upwards, and the tripod will close due to inertia.

1. Pairing

- a. Turn on the shutter by switching the on/off button. The Remote Shutter will enter into pairing mode and indicator LED starts flash quickly at the same time.
- b. Activate the Wireless function on your phone and sourcing the devices around.
- c. Select the device of "Remote Shutter" from the list and pairing will be finished automatic few seconds.

2. Shooting

Click "Camera" of your device, then press the button on the remote shutter to take photos or videos.

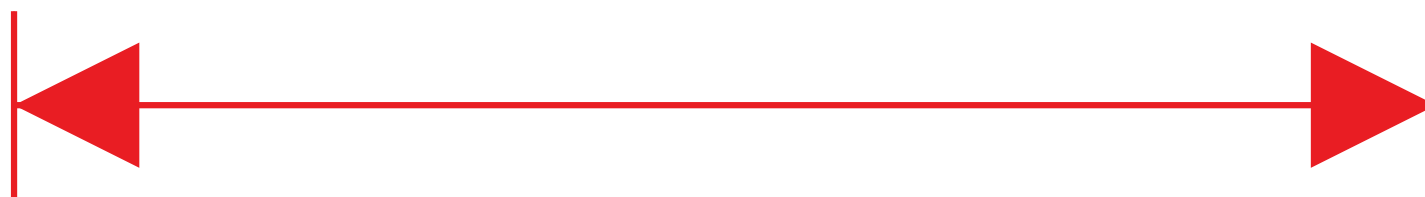
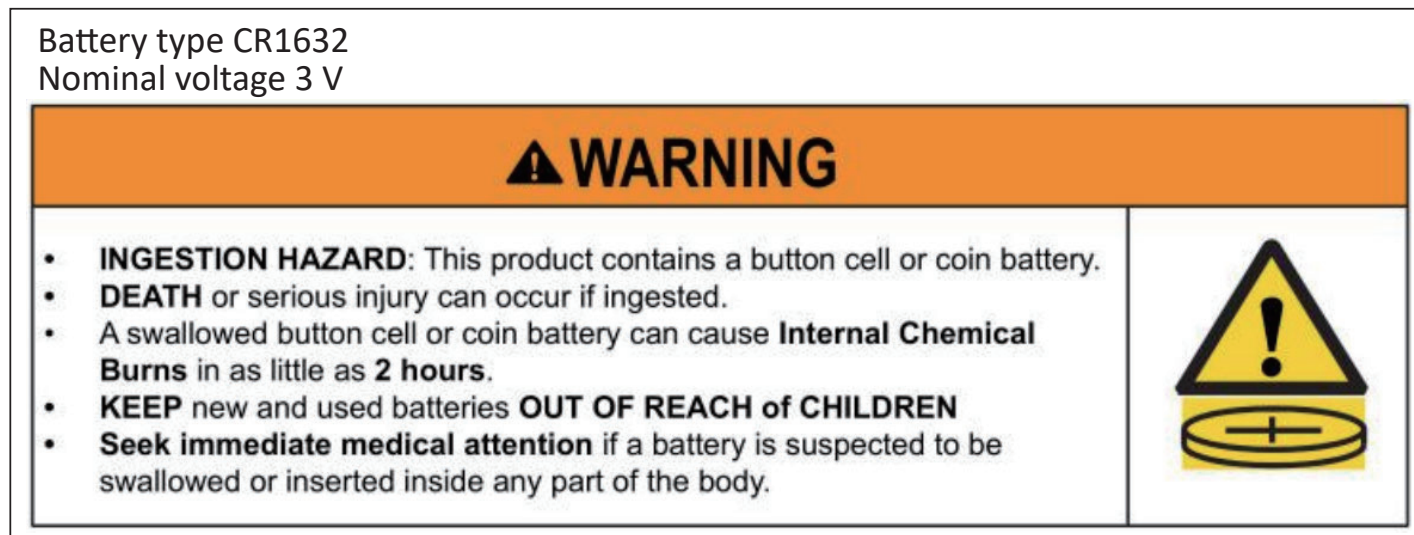
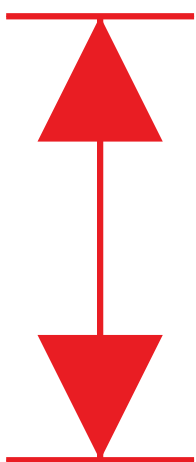
