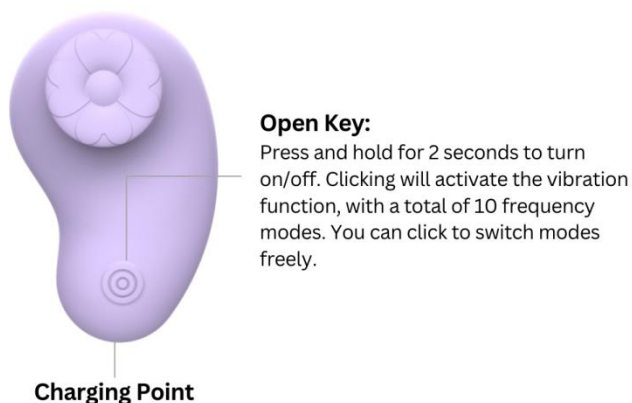


## Fantasia Sense X Product Manual

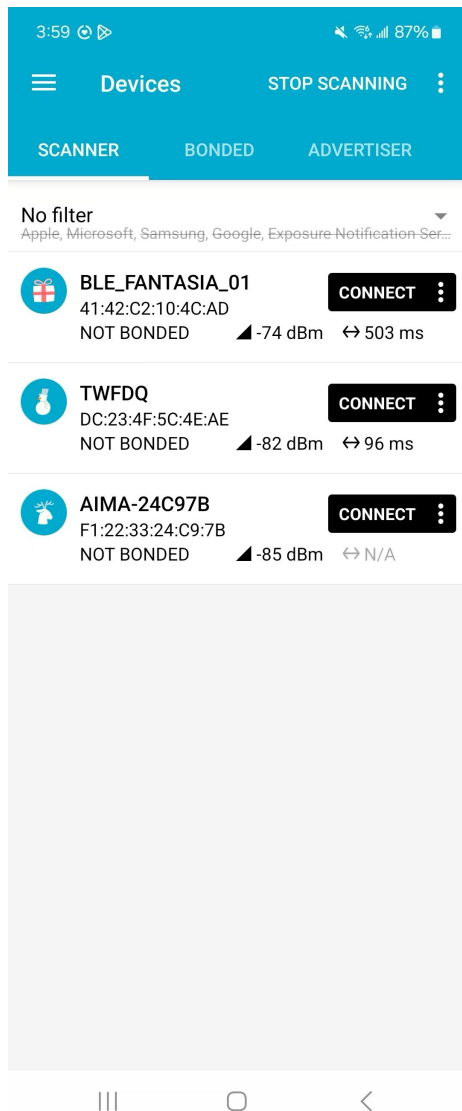

### Bluetooth connection

Enable Bluetooth on your cell phone and set it to discoverable. Then open the designated APP ("nRF Connect") or open the bluetooth setting on your cell phone, and put your toy in te near range to smartphone. Confirm turn on the toy and indicator lights up. Start to search and select "BLE\_FANTASIA\_01" to complete connection. See blow picture for your reference.



## USB charging manual

The packaging contains a charging cable that connects to a USB power adapter or USB port.  
Charging state: Flashing light, full charge state: Long on light.

## Maintenance and upkeep

When not using this product for a long time, please charge it every three months.
