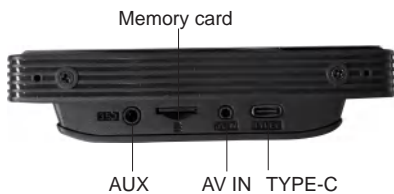

2.SD card specifications (optional)

The quality of SD card has a great influence on the stability of video recording. In order to record video safely, please choose a big brand SD card, such as SanDisk, Kingston, Toshiba, Samsung, etc. The SD card should be at least Class10 level or above. The minimum capacity supports 32GB and the maximum capacity supports 256GB



3. Wiring and installation instructions



- ① Fix carplay on windshield Or on the car center console.
- ② Prepare all kinds of vehicle charging cable, as shown in photo, and put the car charger into cigarette lighter;
- ③ Arrange rear-view camera cable and plug rear-view camera AV connector into car driving recorder AV-in port,connect the Red cable of the camera to car reversing light power positive (Optional) ,then fix the rear-view camera.

- 4 Start car to check if drive recorder turn on automatically and begins recording, if it does, the installation is correct, or else, check car charger and AV connector installation problem.

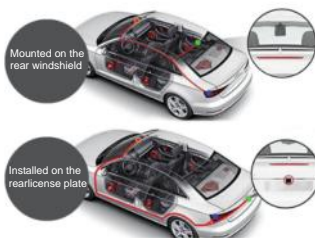


Red line: Connected to the positive pole of the reverse lamp



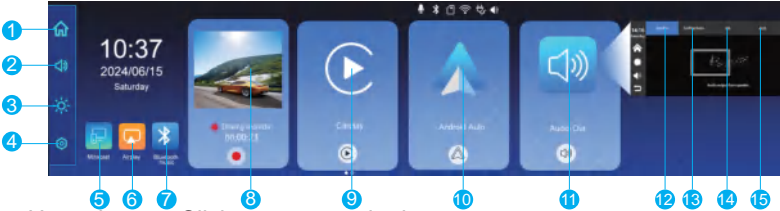
Rear camera line installation

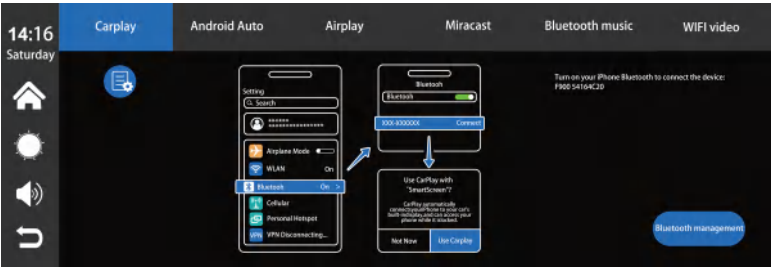

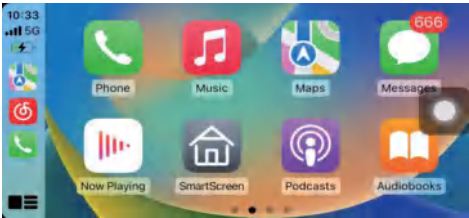

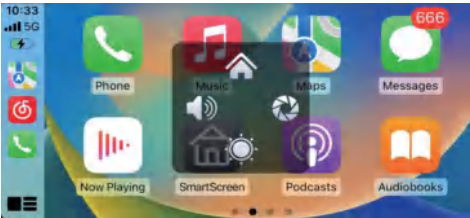
A.CarPlay



As shown in the above figure, click the 'CarPlay' button, then select the 'CarPlay' option, and first turn on the phone's WiFi and Bluetooth, as shown in the above figure. Bluetooth will turn on automatically, named F900-XXXX. Once Bluetooth is connected successfully, you can connect to CarPlay. (When the machine is powered on, it will attempt to connect to the last connected phone automatically)

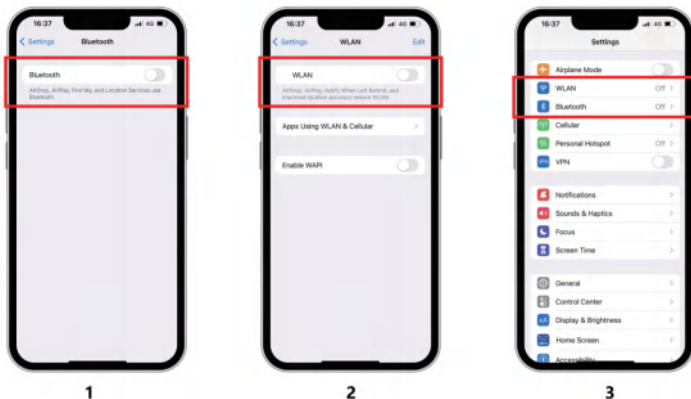


Click Assistive Touch to display the shortcut menu: [Back to Home], [Record Video Screen], [Volume Adjustment], [Brightness Adjustment].

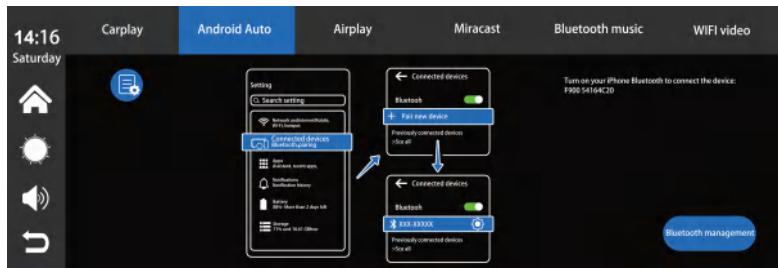


When Assistive Touch is turned off, you can tap the [SmartScreen] button

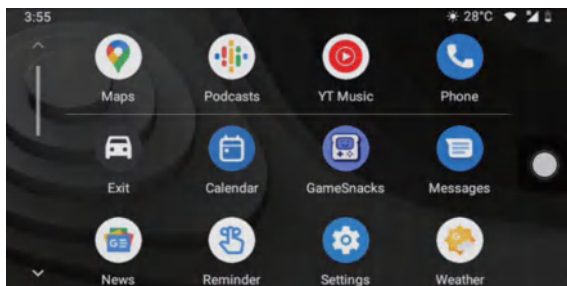

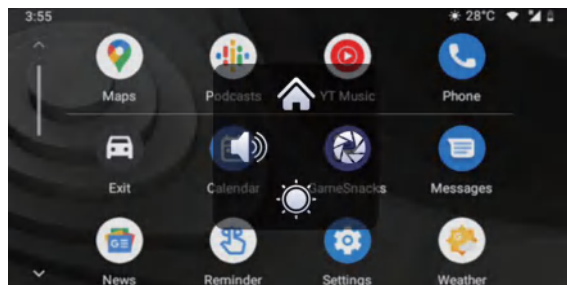
B.Android Auto



As shown in the picture, click the [Auto] button, and then select the [Auto] option, first turn on the phone's Wi-Fi and Bluetooth, as shown in the picture above. Bluetooth will be turned on automatically and the name will be F900-XXXX. Once the Bluetooth is successfully connected, you can connect to Auto. (When the machine is powered on, it will try to connect to the last connected phone automatically)

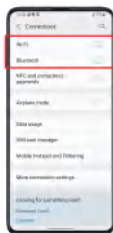


Click Assistive Touch to display the shortcut menu: [Back to Home], [Record Video Screen], [Volume Adjustment], [Brightness Adjustment].

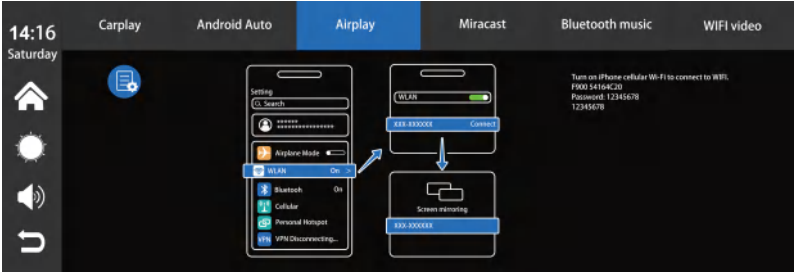


When Assistive Touch is turned off, you can tap the [Exit] button to return to the home page.

(Wireless Auto option is only supported for Android phones. Please forget Bluetooth in your phone's settings and turn off the WiFi button to disconnect).



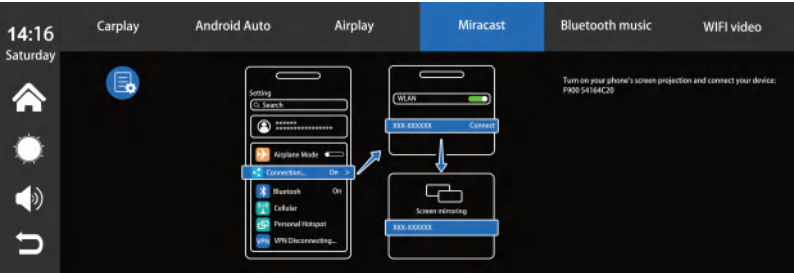
C.AirPlay



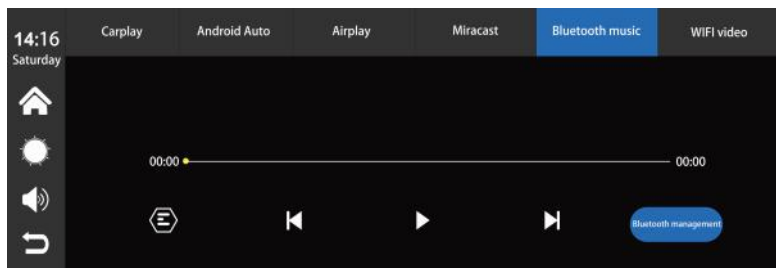

(AirPlay option is only supported for Apple mobile phones.)

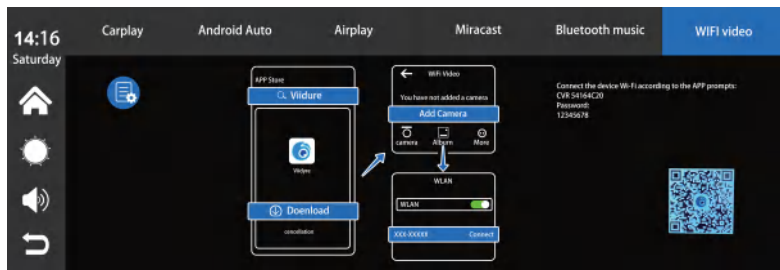

As shown in the above figure, first scan the QR code to download the corresponding app.

After downloading, open the app and follow the prompts to connect to the machine's WiFi. WiFi name: CVR-XXXXXX, password as shown on the machine.

After connecting, the machine will enter the recording interface and cannot perform any operations. You can watch or download recorded videos, set machine parameters, and more on your phone.

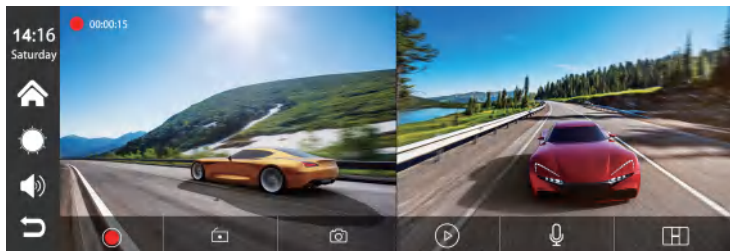

(Turn off the WiFi key on your phone to disconnect, and it will take one minute to disconnect before you can operate on the machine.)



6.DVR

As shown in the picture, the main page will not display the camera image, you need to click the Dvr button  to view the camera image. After inserting the memory card, the system enters the recording mode automatically.



	Tap to start recording the video and tap again to close the recorded video.
	Lock the recorded video and the data will not loop over the recording.
	Click to take a photo with one click.
	Enter the video playback interface
	Turning on and off the sound recording function
	Click to switch camera screen display

Lock the current video:

If too many videos are locked, the first locked video will be overwritten.

The number of videos that can be locked depends on the capacity of the SD memory card. 32G SD memory card can lock 40 videos, when locking the 41st video, the 41st video will overwrite the first one and the 42nd video will overwrite the second one.

64G SD memory card can store 80 locked videos, 128G SD memory card can store 160 locked videos, 256G SD memory card can store 320 locked videos. The SD card supports a minimum of 32GB and a maximum of 256GB!

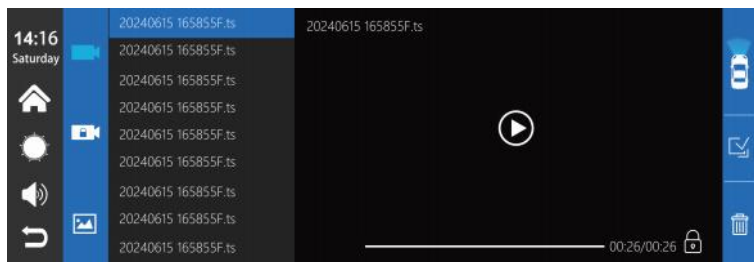
H.Supports dual Bluetooth connection



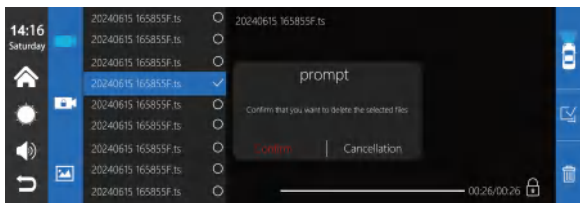
After connecting [CarPlay] or [Auto] for screen casting, you can use your phone's Bluetooth to connect to the Bluetooth headset. After the connection is successful, all sounds from the device will be transmitted to the Bluetooth headset for playback.


7.Playback

As shown in the above figure, click the [Playback] button to enter the Playback interface.



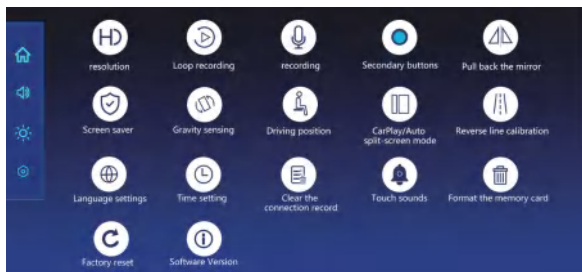
You can select [Video], [Photo], [Locked Video] folder, after selecting, you can click the select button on the right side of the file to delete, lock or unlock the video.



















Click the [] icon, you can switch the video recording playback of front camera and rear camera.

9.Common problems

Number	Problem	Solution
1	Unable to start	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Check whether the power cord is damaged or aged 2. Check whether the fuse of the power cord is disconnected or burnt out
2	No touch phenomenon	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Touch is invalid during power-on, wait for normal power-on before operation. 2. Check whether the touch is damaged, do not touch the screen with sharp objects, it is easy to scratch and damage.
3	No image from camera	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use only after using the manufacturer's matching camera. 2. The camera connector is not loose.
4	High temperature lag phenomenon of the mach	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The normal operating temperature of the MTO2 is -4 to 149 F. If the temperature exceeds the limit, disconnect the power supply and the temperature of the MTO2 will be lower than 149 F before switching on the power.
5	Carplay cannot connect	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The first connection takes a little longer. 2. Only iPhone supports Carplay. 3. Check that the WiFi and Bluetooth functions of the mobile phone are normal. 4. Enter Settings - General - Carplay vehicle, delete all records and reconnect. 5. Restart the iPhone and reconnect it. 6. Turn on the Siri function on your phone.
6	Auto cannot connect	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Only Android phones are supported. 2. Update Auto and related applications on mobile phones to the latest version. 3. Do not enable VPN on the mobile phone. 4. Check that the WiFi and Bluetooth functions of the mobile phone are normal. 5. Restart the Android phone and connect it again.
7	WiFi Video cannot connect	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Try to upgrade the version of the application. 2. Check if the SD card of the machine exists. 3. Check if the machine's mode has been switched to WiFi video mode.
