SMART PIXEL MOBILE ELECTRONIC SCREEN

BASIC PARAMETERS

COLOR: BLACK

VOLTAGE: TYPE-C DC 5V

STABDBY TIME: \approx 10Days (Which is equivalent to one day of normal mobile phone use)

BATTERY CAPACITY

If extending the display time, increasing the brightness, or frequent high-frequency displays, may lead to reduced usage time of the phone case due to low battery, which is a normal phenomenon. Simply charge the phone for 5-10 minutes could resolve it.

QUICK OVERVIEW

P-One is a smart pixel mobile phone screen that not only provides phone protection, but also displays and switches the rich and interesting retro Mosaic images on the back of the phone case through the mobile APP.

PICBUTTON User Manual

- In the power-off state, press and hold for 2 seconds to power on, then you can scan, Click to view the Bluetooth device code and connect to the corresponding name.
- In the power-on state, press and hold for 2 seconds to enter rhythm mode. In rhythm mode, press and hold for 2 seconds to exit rhythm mode. In the power-on state, press and hold for 7 seconds to power off.
- In HiD mode, there are three button modes available (single click, doubleclick, triple click).

You can customize the shortcut functions for the corresponding modes.

Under normal usage conditions, the phone case can be charged while the.

This device does not use mobile phone battery power, do not worry about mobile phone battery life reduction.

The TYPE-C interface at the bottom is inserted into the mobile phone to better protect the dust of the mobile phone interface.

When installing the phone case, please pay attention to the bottom Angle of the phone (the Angle should not be too large). Insert the TYPE-C port diagonally, and then push the top of the phone to install the phone cover

Connect Device

1. Please long press for 2 seconds to scan after the device is powered on. Click to view the corresponding name of the Bluetooth device code for connection.

2. Search for PICDANCE in the APPSTORE to download. 

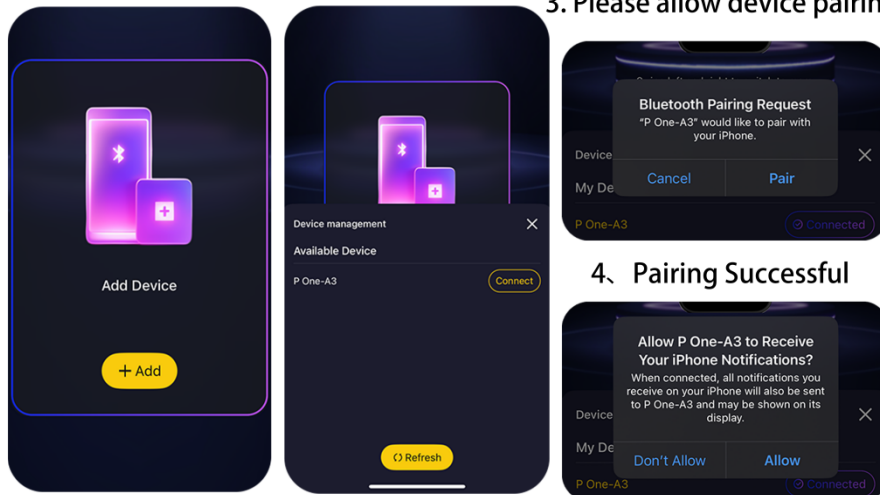
3. Enter the phone system setting-Bluetooth, turn on Bluetooth, open the PICDANCE APP to connect P-ONE device.

PicDance app Function Authorization and Bluetooth Connection

1. Open the Picdance app to connect to the device

2. According to your P-One device ID to Bluetooth connection

3. Please allow device pairing



4. Pairing Successful

Once your device is successfully connected to P-One, PicDance app will allow you to edit.

The connection pairing must be authorized; otherwise, the device cannot be used.

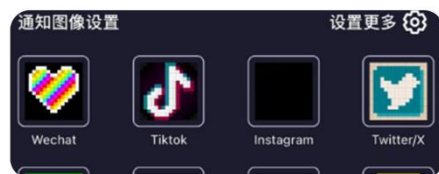
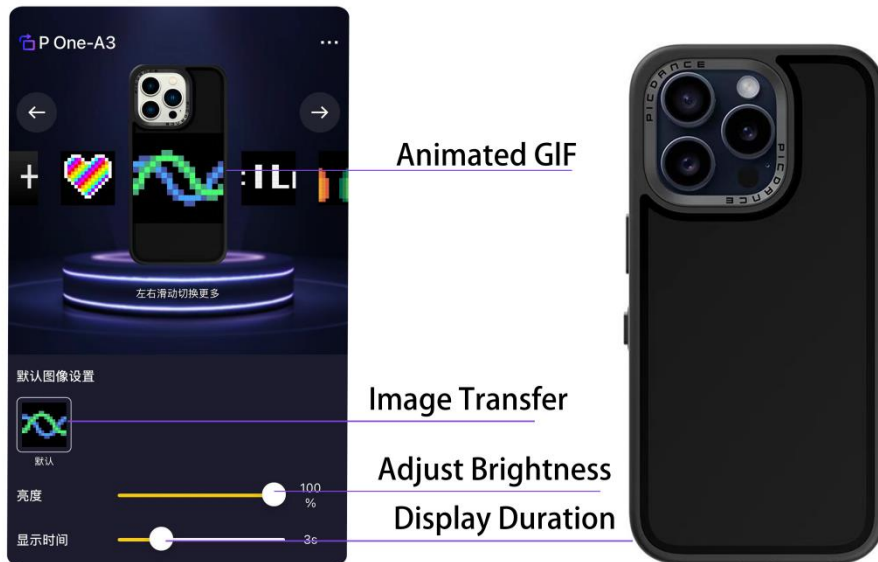


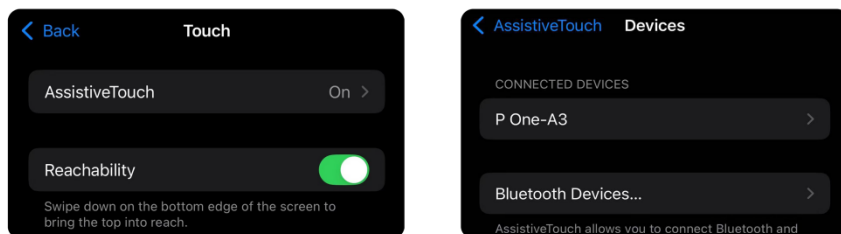
Image editing for APP Message Notifications

You can edit the notification content of the corresponding APP

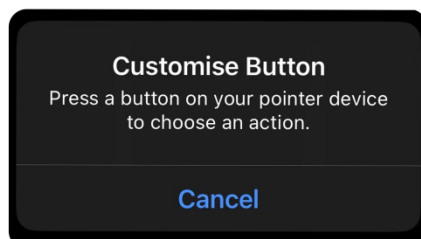
FUNCTION KEY BUTTON

Create buttons manually after pairing

1. The following takes the "Click" operation as an example: Go to "Accessibility - Touch" in system Settings and open "Accessibility Touch".

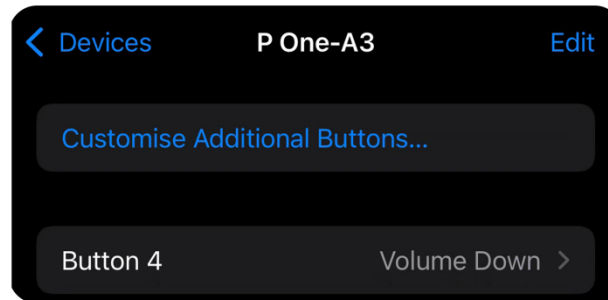


2. Then find and enter the "Device" menu, select "P-ONE Define more button", which can enter the setting state, a pop-up window will appear at this time.

3. At this point, click the Picdance Button, which creates a button for the appropriate corresponding action in IOS. If the creation is successful, a button option will be added to the menu.



After the button is created, you can enter the menu of the corresponding button to assign system functions or shortcut commands to the button. The initial setup of P-One is complete and you can change the Settings at any time in the system Setting. The number and type of shortcut commands in this menu depend on the shortcut commands already installed in the shortcut APP.

****Button names depend on the order in which the buttons were created.**

Usage of Pic Button

Get shortcut instruction

A shortcut command allows you to complete one or more tasks using an App. You are advised to add a shortcut command to the App.

1. Open the shortcut command app in your phone (installed by default. If it has been uninstalled, you can search for "shortcut instructions" in the AppStore to download it again) .
2. Click "Shortcuts Gallery" and click any shortcut command you like.
3. Click "Add shortcut command" and your first shortcut command has been added.

How to use the “Pic Button”

Picdance Button provides two key modes: one click and double click. Each button can be registered in the iOS system Settings to set up a corresponding system function or shortcut command. For details about how to set the button, please refer to the section "Create Button for the First Time".

If you do not want to display the assistive touch menu (commonly known as “white dot”) on the screen, you can choose to turn off the “Always Show menu” in the system Settings “Accessibility” – “Assistive Touch” .
