
Using Instructions

1. Power on

Long press the button on the right side, to power on the device.

Notes

1. If you want to shut down, please long press the button.
2. After shutting down, the screen will still display content, but it does not consume power, which is a characteristic of eink screens.




2. Connect Network

1. Click the [Settings] icon on the lower left corner, then click [Network].
2. Click [Scan], then click the WiFi you want to connect to, enter the WiFi password, and click [Connect].
3. After the connection is successful, you can log in to your account.

Notes

1. If you want to connect hidden WiFi, please click [Join others] and enter the WiFi name and password.
2. Currently we only support 2.4G WiFi, if the WiFi is 5G, please turn on WiFi compatibility mode, and give 2.4G WiFi a different name.



3. Download APP


1. Scan the QR code to download the [NarTick APP].
2. Sign up with a phone number or email.
3. Click [Mine] - [Scan]. This will be needed in the next step.

4. Log In

1. Click [My Info] on NarTick E-Calendar, then click [Login].
2. Use the NarTick APP to scan the QR code on the screen and click [Confirm Login].
3. The login status will be automatically synchronized on the device; if it is not synchronized, click [Have logged].




4. After successful, the current page will display your account information.

5. Experience Features

After successful login, the schedule data in NarTick APP will be automatically synchronized to the device.

1. Switch to [List] in the mobile APP, then click [+] in the lower right corner to create a task, and add a time for the task. You will be reminded at the preset time.
2. Click the first navigation in the top-left corner of E-Calendar, and your data will be synchronized to the device.
3. When the preset time of the task item arrives, NarTick will play sound to remind you.



Notice for use

1. You can subscribe Google, Apple, and Outlook calendars, and NarTick will automatically synchronize schedules and remind you.
2. NarTick supports sharing tasks with others. You can create tasks for your family remotely, and then E-Calendar will remind your family.
3. E-Calendar will synchronize data from the server every 15 minutes; when you need to refresh immediately, click the [Refresh] icon in the lower left corner.
4. There will be refresh afterimages on the e-ink screen. You can click the [refresh] icon clear the afterimages.
5. The device will turn on the Dont-disturb mode by default at night, then notifications will be mute, and the frequency of data synchronization will be reduced. You can change Dont-disturb mode time.
