2. HEATING TEMPERATURE

The heating temperature is adjustable from 86°F-158°F.

3. HOW TO CLEAN

We recommend wiping insoles with a wet towel, please do not rinse it with water.

4. BATTERY MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- Please store the product at room temperature.
- If you do not use the insoles for a long time, you need to fully charge the battery before storing it.
- To protect the battery's life, please charge the battery once at least every 3 months, long-term non-electricity may cause damage to the internal battery core.
- Please keep the metal contacts of the battery and insoles clean.

5. SAFETY WARNINGS

- Please don't wear the insole without batteries installed.
- Please don't store near a heat source (like a fire or heater) and moisture.
- Please don't use the insoles supply in an extremely hot environment (such as direct sunlight). Overheating the power supply will affect the performance of the battery and shorten the service life of the battery!

6. HOW TO USE

● Charge

Battery: Charging—Orange light, Fully charged—Green light
Note: Please fully charge before the first use.


● Battery Switch Control

Long press the battery switch 3S to turn it ON/OFF, short press to adjust the gear. (When not using the APP, you can use the insole using this method)

● APP Control


Step 1) Download the APP

Please search and download the "WarmLife" APP from the App Store or Google Play, or scan the following QR code to download the App.




Step 5) Long press the batteries switch to turn on the batteries, then click ①, then click ② to confirm the connection.
(Left and right insoles need to be connected separately)

Note: If the APP does not scan the battery, please make sure the Bluetooth and location function of your phone is turned on, click ③ to refresh the search device.




Step 6) Connected

Insoles icon turns red to indicate successful connection, green battery icon shows battery level.
(If the connection fails, please check whether the BT and location are turned on, repeat Step5)



Step 7) APP Control Instruction



① APP connection status icon description



① Select the insoles you want to control, the insoles icon turns red to indicate it is controlled

② Toggle the "F/C" display.

③ Click ON/OFF to turn the device ON/OFF(StandBy), The OFF is the StandBy mode. If you want to completely turn off the device, please long press the battery switch.

Note: The battery in StandBy mode will continue to consume a small amount of battery power, to keep connected to the mobile. If you do not need to continue to heat, please long press the battery switch to turn off the battery.

④ Slide the progress bar to adjust the temperature.
