Model: M2+

### Installing the SIM Cards and the Battery

A SIM card carries useful information, including your mobile phone number, PIN (Personal Identification Number), PIN2, PUK (PIN Unlocking Key), PUK2 (PIN2 Unlocking Key), IMSI (International Mobile Subscriber Identity), network information, contacts data, and short messages data.

#### **Installation**

- ◆ Hold the End key for a while to power off the mobile phone.
- ◆ Take the back cover above the battery away.
- ◆ Take the battery away.
- ◆ Insert the SIM card into the SIM card slot lightly with the corner cutting of the card aligning to the notch of the slot and the gold plate of the card facing down, till the SIM card cannot be further pushed in.
- ◆ With the metallic contacts of the battery facing the metallic contacts in the battery slot, press the battery down until it locks into place.

#### **Installing T-Flash Card**

The T-Flash card is a pluggable mobile storage card inside the mobile phone.

To install the T-Flash card, open its latch, place its indented side downward, insert the card into the card slot, and then close the latch.

To remove the T-flash card, open its latch and slightly take the card out. And then close the

latch.

Using the Menus

## Settings

### ◆ Phone settings:

- **Date and Time:** set the date format, the time format, and detail time of the location.

***Note:** If you remove the battery from the mobile phone or if the battery energy was exhausted a long time ago, you may need to reset the date and time when re-inserting the battery or powering on the mobile phone after recharging.*

- **Language:** Select the display language and writing language for the mobile phone.
- **Shortcut settings:** Select preferred input Shortcut.
- **Auto power on/off:** Customize the on/off time, and the phone will switch on/off according to the defined time.
- **Browser selection:** Choose an option as your browser.
- **Restore factory settings:** Use this function to restore factory settings. The preset password is 1122.

- ◆ **Display:** Users can access this item to set Wallpaper, Idle display, Contrast, Backlight and Auto keypad lock etc.

### ◆ Security:

- **Phone locked:** The function enables you to lock/unlock the phone. Entering password to switch on or off the phone. Password is required when the phone is locked.
- **Privacy:** Set a password. When it comes to privacy related functions, you need to enter the correct password to access.

➤ **Auto keypad lock:**After setting a certain period of time, the keyboard will automatically lock.

➤ **Modify the cellphone password:** You can change your password.

➤ **Lock screen by end-key:** You can press the end-key to lock your phone

➤ **Blacklist:** You can set the contacts to blacklist, stop this contact calls, or information.

◆ **Call settings:**

➤ **Auto handfree:** Automatically turn on hands-free during calls.

➤ **Dual SIM :** You can set standby mode, reply by original SIM, set SIM name and set dual SIM call divert through this function.

➤ **Flip to answer:** You can open your phone to automatically answer calls.

◆ **Connections:**Choose your network connection

◆ **SOS:**

➤ **SOS number list:** Enter the number you need as your emergency number.

➤ **SOS message settings:** You can edit emergency messages.

➤ **SOS settings:** You can enable the SOS function and alarm ringtone function.

➤ **Help:**SOS help info.

## **Contacts**

This feature can view and manage the telephone number information in the machine and in the SIM card.

## **Messages**

Through this function, you can create, read or send new SMS

*Note: If the short message memory is full, a blinking SMS icon appears on the top of the screen. To normally receive short messages, you need to delete some of the existing short messages.*

### **Call logs**

Missed calls, Dialed calls, Received calls, Rejected calls, Delete all, Call timers, GPRS counter, You can view a list of the above.

- **Call logs:** You can view all call logs.
  
- **Missed calls:** You can view missed phone information, including the phone number you dialed, the time you dialed, and the number of repeated calls.
  
- **Dialed number:** Record the number of calls already made, including the phone number dialed, the time and number of calls made, etc.
  
- **Received calls:** Record the received calls, check the phone number, call time, and duration of the dialed calls.
  
- **Rejected calls:** Record rejected calls, check the phone number and time of the call. You can also choose whether to make a call, delete records, and so on.
  
- **Delete all:** You can choose to delete all records in a certain call record list, such as dialed calls, rejected calls, etc.
  
- **Call timers:** Record the continuous call time, broadcast call time, and total received call time, and can also reset all call times.
  
- **Data service counter:** It includes functions such as data traffic statistics, traffic generated during phone calls, traffic generated during phone calls, and resetting all traffic data records.

## Application

### ◆ Services:

Internet service: The internet network is the application platform which wireless communication combine with with Internet ,it can make you get plentiful Internet information resources and electronic commerce application by phone.

Note: 1. Your Internet service provider may not support the certain functions, in order to guarantee the normal operation of the browser line, please confirm your SIM card has support the Internet service.

2.when you browse the web,it will costs related flow fee, the expenses please enquiry local operators.

◆ **Family numbers:** When you activated the function, in standby mode, you can long press the key 1.2.3.4.5.6.7.8.9 to call coressponding number.

◆ **Sign light:** You can choose to turn on the light when you need it.

◆ **Alarm:** You can set three alarms through this function.

◆ **Calculator:**You can calculate in this function.

◆ **Calendar:** Once you enter this menu, there is a monthly-view calendar for you to keep track of important appointments, etc. Days with events entered will be marked.

## Multimedia

◆ **DV:** Use this function to play camera.

◆ **Audio:** Use this function to play audio files.

◆ **Video:**You can play recorded or saved video files. When playing videos, you can freely switch, pause, play in full screen, etc.

- ◆ **Image:** View all pictures on your phone, allowing you to browse, delete, and send pictures, etc
- ◆ **Recorder:** To shoot a video, press the OK key to start recording, and you can choose to pause and save the recorded video. The submenu implements recording related settings.

### **My files**

The phone supports the memory card. The capacity of the memory-card is selectable. You can use the file manager to conveniently manage various directories and files on the memory card.

### **Profiles**

You may customize the profiles and activate any profile in order to use a specific function. You may set the ring signal, adjust volume, the ring type and the alert rings.

### **Camera**

In the options of camera interface, you may set image viewer, camcorder, effect, settings. You may enter the Image viewer to view the pictures. Press the middle (OK) key to take pictures.
