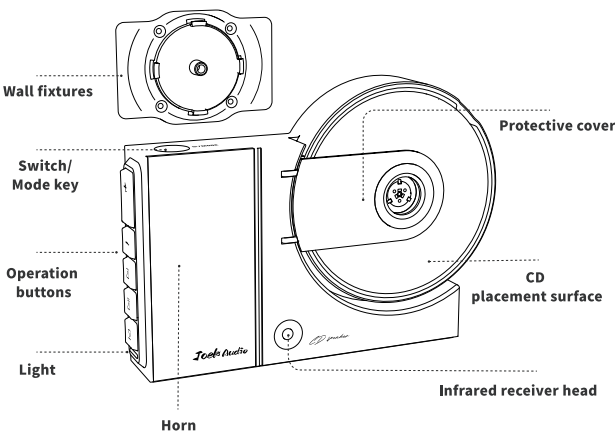

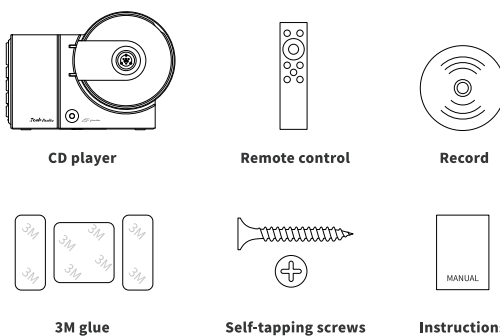

Functional operation instructions

1 CD mode (default when booted)

- Built-in speaker playback**
(1) Long press the power button on the top, and the indicator light will be solid green
(2) Open the protective cover and put in the CD disc
(3) Close the protective cover

- Bluetooth output**
(1) Press and hold the " + " button in CD mode (with a disc), and the green light will flash
(2) Wait a few seconds to automatically connect to nearby devices
(3) The connection is successful, long press the " - " button to switch devices
(4) Long press the " + " button to turn off the Bluetooth output, and the green light is always on

- 3.5 Line output**
In CD mode (with discs) connect the headphones/adaptor cables
Plug in the " AUX " port (Bluetooth transmitter priority playback)

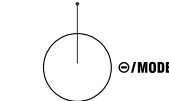
2 Bluetooth mode

- (1) Long press the top power button to power on
(2) Short press the top " MODE " button to switch to Bluetooth mode,
Hear a voice prompt and a blue light flashes
(3) Open your phone's Bluetooth settings
(4) Select the device " JaekAudio C20 " to match
(5) The pairing is successful, and the blue light is always on
(6) Select music playback on your phone

3 USB mode

- (1) Long press the top power button to power on
(2) Short press the top " MODE " button to switch to USB mode, Hear the voice prompt and the red light is always on
(3) Insert the USB flash drive into the " USB " port

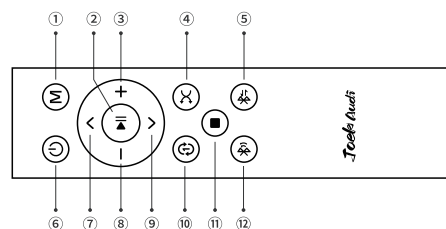

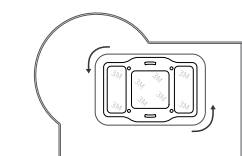

Wall mounting instructions

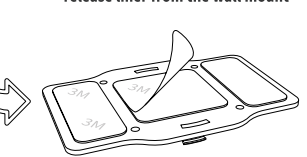
1 Detach the wall mount

Place the wall mount on the back of the CD player counterclockwise
Rotate 45 degrees to remove the wall mount vertically



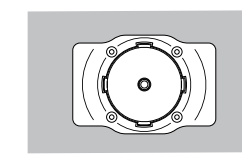
2 Tear off 3M release liners

Remove three pieces of 3M adhesive release liner from the wall mount



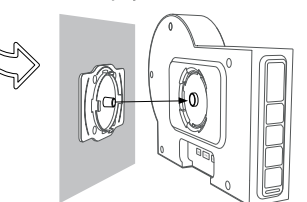
3 Sticking to the wall fixture

Attach the wall fixing frame horizontally to the target wall and press it moderately to make the adhesive surface fit



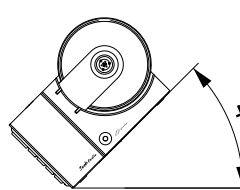
4 Hole alignment

Align and insert the round table with the raised center of the wall mount and insert it into the round hole on the CD player



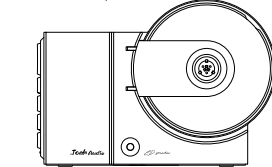
5 45 degree angle snap in

Tilt the CD player to 45 degrees, shake it lightly and press to snap into the card slot



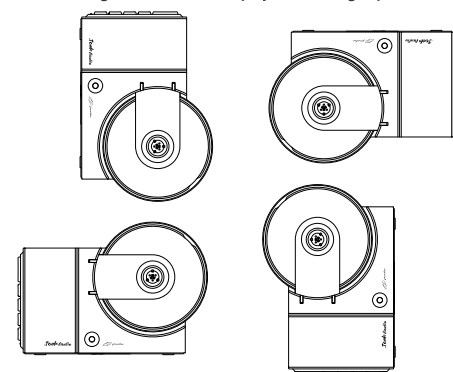
6 Complete the installation

Rotate the CD player 45° clockwise to complete the installation
(Disassembly can be completed by rotating 45° counterclockwise after installation)



Four ways to present

The card slot can be snapped into the card slot at a 45° angle in any direction, and four wall mounting methods can be displayed according to preference



Precautions

- Read this note carefully and keep it.
- This product is suitable for use in an indoor ventilated environment, please keep away from places with high humidity, high temperature and dust.
- Place a disc or protect the jammed paper on the device to avoid unnecessary damage to the CD bald head assembly.
- When replacing a CD, stop spinning completely and replace the disc.
- It is forbidden to touch the disc with your hands or other items while the device is running.
- Clean this product with a dry cloth only.
- Do not place the unit near a container filled with liquids or dripping water.
- Do not install near any heat source, such as radiators, hot air regulators, stoves, or other heat-generating instruments.
- Protect the power cord from being stepped on or pinched, especially at plugs, sockets, and product power outlets.
- Please use the accessories/accessories provided by the manufacturer.
- When attaching the wall mount, clean the adhesive surface and keep the adhesive surface dry and free of dust, oil stains, moisture, etc.
- Avoid touching the glued surface with your fingers, and it is recommended to stick the wall mount for 24 hours before installing the CD player.
- Please do not wall hang inferior walls, water-stained walls, rough walls, peeling walls, painted walls, or cracked walls.

- When installing the CD player, make sure that the CD player is fixed in place with the holder and that there is no loosening.
