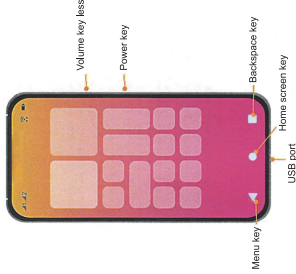
- Send and reply messages**
1. Send a message: open the messaging application and tap the plus sign to create a blank message. You can select the recipient among your contacts or add the phone number manually. Enter your message and tap "send".
 2. Reply to a message: tap a message you received and enter your reply in the field below. Tap "send" when you have completed.
 3. Select a sim card for outgoing messages if you have two sim CARDS on your device, you will be asked which sim card to use before sending a message.

3- basic functions of the home screen

1. All the applications you install on your device are shown in the boot up. However, it is not the only feature it offers.
2. Uninstall applications to uninstall an application, hold down its icon and then drag it into the trash can at the top of the screen.
3. Select applications to view as wallpaper > select applications to view as home screen > select applications to view as lock screen > tap "apply" and select the application you want to use as the home screen.
4. Move application icons: drag down an application to select it and then drag it to a new location.
5. Create new folders: drag an application over another application to create a folder. After this, you will be able to edit the folder name.

4-use of the battery

4-use of the battery
Open the system Settings and tap "battery" to see how your device consumes power. You can check the battery level and capacity. Enable battery saving to reduce application background activity, stop synchronization and minimize system animations. Battery usage allows you to check the status of power consumption of different applications and hardware elements.



1 - basic characteristic

- Turn on and off the cell**
1. **Power on:** hold down the power button to turn on your phone.
 2. **Power off:** press and hold the power button until the menu appears. Tap "switch off". If your device does not respond, press the power button for 15 seconds to force reboot.
 3. **Restart:** hold down the power button and turn down the volume at the same time until the menu appears. Tap "restart".

1. Sim, usim and tf card insertion: use the sim tray removal tool provided to remove the sim tray from the side of your phone. Place your sim card inside the tray and insert it into your device.

2. Sim, usim and tf card removal: use the sim tray removal tool provided to remove the sim tray from the side of your phone. Remove your sim card from the tray and insert the tray back into your device.

When your phone's battery is running out, connect the usb cable to the phone and connect it to the adapter connected to a power outlet. Disconnect the charger when your phone is fully charged. 1. Uninstall applications you can uninstall several applications using this function. Select the applications and tap the button below.
2. Applications and notification Settings allow you to manage the permissions of all applications installed on your device. Manage permissions for individual applications. You can verify all permissions an application has by touching the application. The switches located next to each permission allow you to grant or restrict access quickly. You can also sort permissions by type to verify all applications that have a specific permission. Permission.
