Friis transmission formula: Pd=(Pout*G)\(4*pi*R2)

Where

Pd= Power density in mW/cm²

Pout=output power to antenna in Mw

G= gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi=3.1416

R= distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd the limit of MPE. If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance where the MPE limit is reached.
