### ■ Operating instructions



- ⏻ Power on
- ⏻ Long press 5 seconds (power off)
- ⏻ Power on
- ⏻ Long press 5 seconds (on)
- ⏻ Play/pause
- ⏻ Click
- ⏻ Double click
- ⏻ Switch RGB light
- ⏻ Three strikes
- ⏻ TWS Pairing/TWS Unpairing
- ⏻ Click
- ⏻ Answer call/Hang up the phone

### ■ Bluetooth pairing

1. First boot, automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode,  
in the connection device search for "M99" select and connect.



2. If it has been successfully paired,  
the audio automatically back to connect the last device,  
5 seconds back to connect successfully, then enter the matching mode.  
If the match is not successful, 5-10 minutes after the automatic shutdown.  
Shutdown state, press 5 seconds can be re-forced matching.

### ■ Instructions for use of accessories

1. The adhesive surface of the back of the driving magnetic disc is pasted on  
the back case of the mobile phone or other surfaces, which can be used for  
adsorbing the sound system. The actual situation may depend on the user's  
individual needs.
