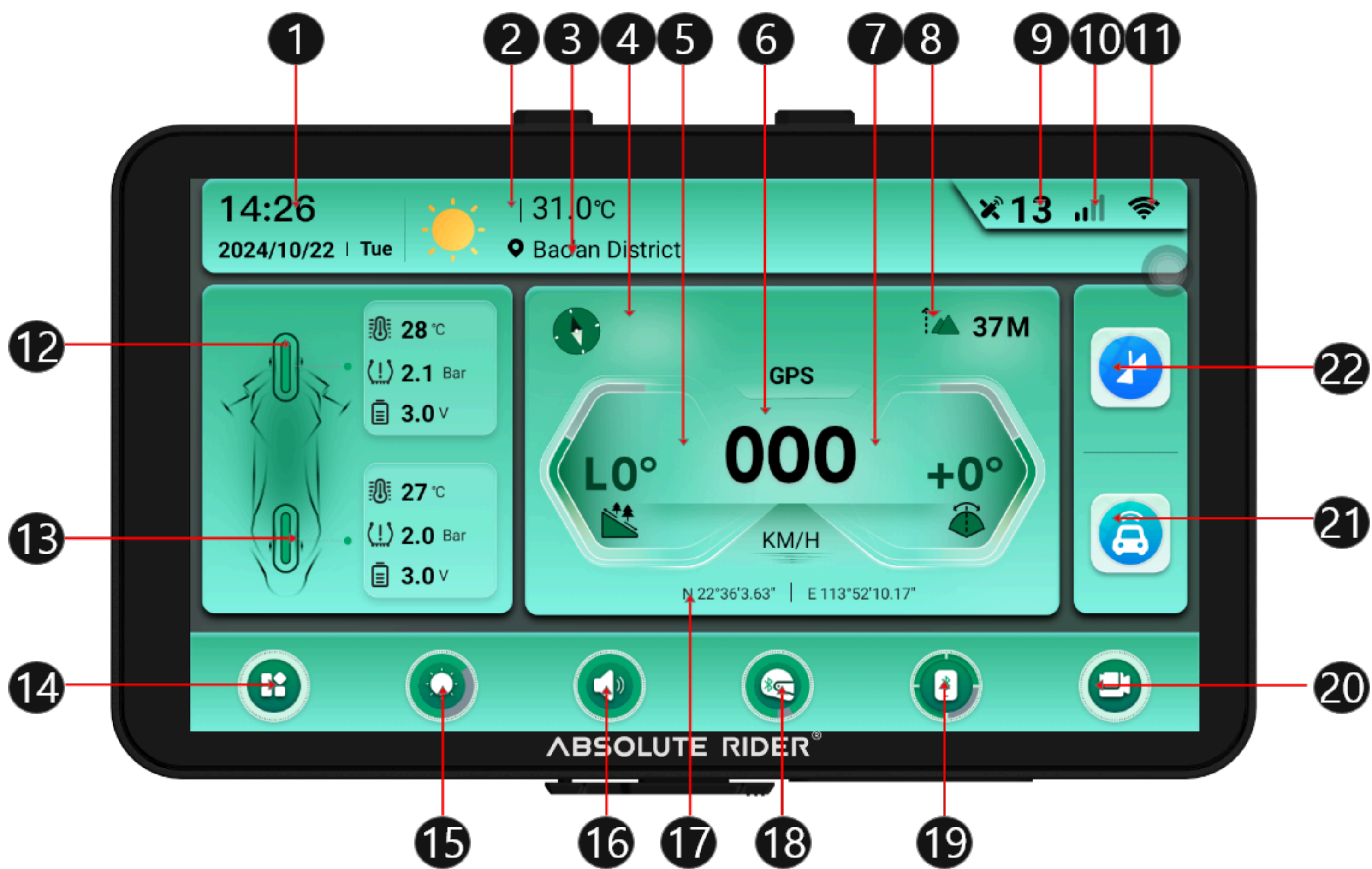

Touch - Gesture Operation



Return to the main interface:
Swipe up with one finger from the bottom



Return to the previous interface:
Swipe from the left/right side to the middle with one finger



Enter the task manager:
Swipe up from the bottom and hold

Bluetooth Phone Operation

Make a Call



1 Directly input a phone number:

Click the phone icon on the vehicle's menu interface, then click the dial pad. After inputting the phone number, click the dial icon to make a call.

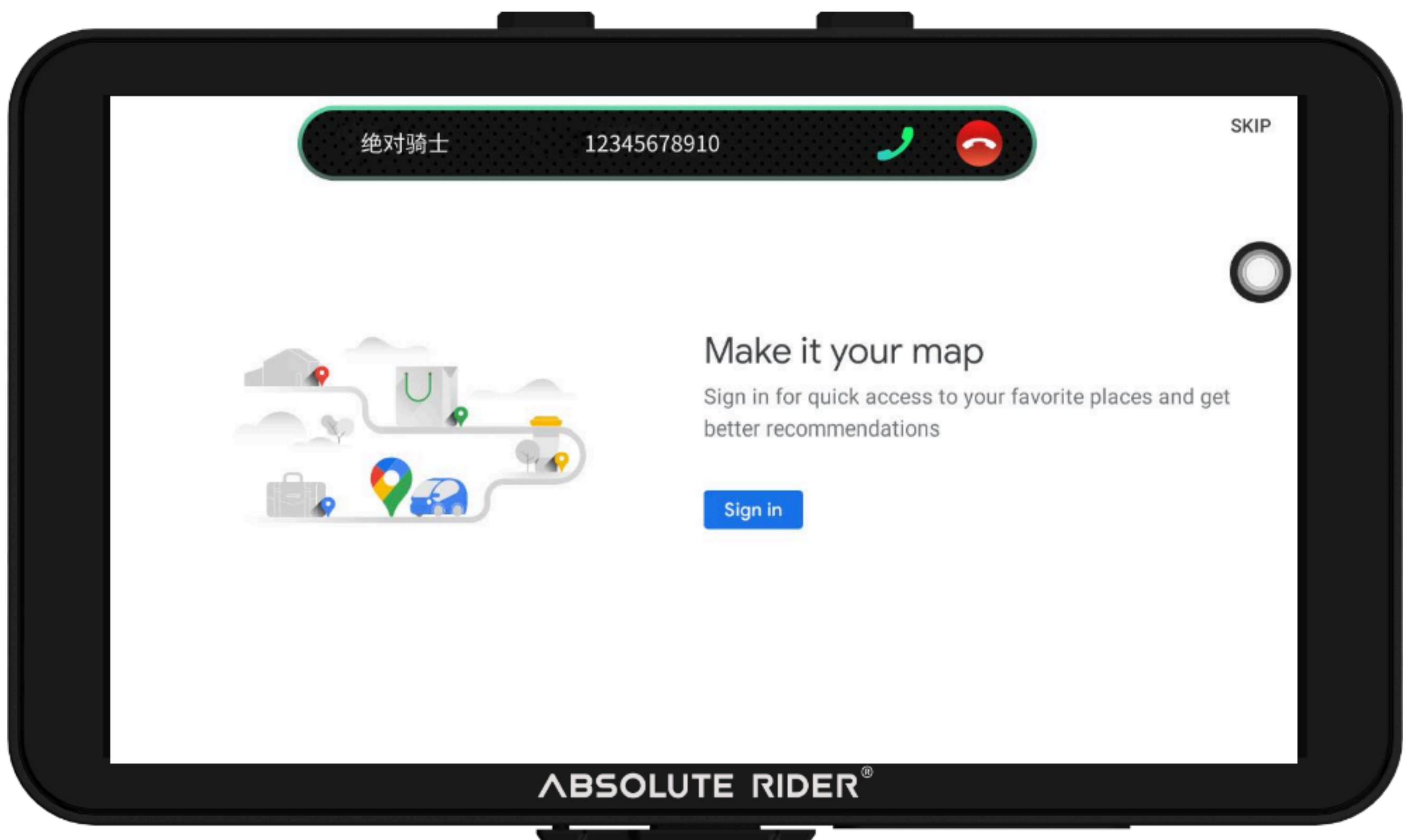
2 Contact list dialing:

Find and select the contact to be dialed in the contact interface.

Answer and hang up



3 Answer and hang up calls:

When a call comes in while using other functions, the call information will appear as a pop-up window at the top of the screen. At this time, you can answer or hang up through the indicated buttons on the page without interrupting the function currently in use.

Driving Recorder Operation

Enter the Recorder



Click the Recorder icon on the application interface to enter the driving recorder interface.

Driving Recorder Operation

Page Information



From left to right at the bottom of the interface, the icons are as follows:

1. **Lock video recording / unlock** (recorded files after locking will not be overwritten).
2. **Start video recording / stop video recording.**
3. **Take a photo.**
4. **File management** (query recorded files).
5. **Settings.**
6. **Switch view** (switch between front - and rear - camera views).
