





Functions and Operations


Power On/Off
Power on: Press and hold the MFB for about 3 seconds to power on the headphones. Red and blue lights flash alternately.
Power off: Press and hold the MFB for about 3 seconds to power off the headphones. Red light flashes twice.

Connection
Step 1: Press and hold the MFB for about 3 seconds to power on the headphones. Red and blue lights flash alternately.
Step 2: Turn on Bluetooth on your device (cell phones or PC or other devices), and search "IM01".
Step 3: When your device searched "IM01". Click "IM01" to make them connected. The blue light will flashes when connected successfully.
(This product has bluetooth memory function, just open the headset and device again to use, and it will automatically reconnect.)



Clear Pairing Mode
Power on the headphones, press V+ and V- at the same time for more than 3 seconds, and release the buttons when you hear the "disconnected" tone. The red and blue lights will flash alternately when clear pairing successfully.

About Music/Calling




1.Single click the MFB once to play/pause music.
2.Press and hold the volume+ for 3 seconds to next track.
3.Press and hold the volume- for 3 seconds to previous track.
4.Single click the Volume+/- once to turn up/down the volume.
5.Click the MFB twice to redial the last call.
6.Single click MFB to answer/end a call.
7.Press and hold the MFB for about 2 seconds to reject the call.
8.Press and hold the MFB, then release it after you hear the tone to activate voice assistant.


Mode Introduction

ANC Mode
Power on the headphones, the ANC will be ON automatically. Single click ANC button to cycles to ANC ON, Transparency and ANC OFF Mode.

Wired Mode
NOTE: If aux audio cable plugged, in wired mode, you can only listen to music but not make calls. ANC function, Bluetooth connection and all the buttons will be unavailable.

2.Charging on wall charge
When charging, the red LED light is always on, and when fully charged, the LED light goes out, and the device cannot be turned on during charging.
