Call Center

You can check the recent call status in the call center.

(Not answering the phone); Display a list of missed calls, select one after a missed call, and you will be able to view the date, time, phone number, and time.

(dialed phone number); Display a list of dialed phone numbers, select one after making a call, and you will be able to view the date, time, phone number, and time.

(Received phone calls); Display a list of received calls, select one, and you will be able to view the date, call time, phone number, and frequency.

(The phone call was refused); Display a list of rejected calls, select one after missing a call, and you will be able to view the date, time, phone number, and time.

Press the OK button to enter the options menu, there may be multiple call records as follows

* Details; View current recordings with date, time, and type.

* Call; Call the current number.

* Save; You can save the current recording of your phone's SIM card.

* Write information; Send the current recording via SMS.

* Add to contact person; Add the recording number to the blacklist with the current added name

* Add the recorded number to the blacklist to reject calls from that number.

* Delete; Delete the number you have selected.

* Delete all; Delete all calls.

* Brand; Marking operation.

(Delete all); Delete all calls.
