Troubleshooting

If you can not connect the headset to your compatible device, check that the headset is charged, switched on and paired with the device or if in bluetooth mode. If all failed, please contact with your distributor

alert

To redial the number you last called (If your mobile device supports this feature with headset), when no call is in progress, press the ON/OFF key twice

To switch a call from the headset to a compatible mobile device, press the key **ON/OFF**, or switch off headset. To switch a call back to the headset, press the **ON/OFF** key, or switch on the headset.

Listen to music

To listen to music, connect the headset to a compatible music player
1. If you receive or make a call while listening to music, the music is paused until you end the call. To play a song, select it in the music player or press **>** or **<**key. To pause or stop playing, press the **ON/OFF** key.

Charge the battery

1. Connect the charger to a wall outlet
2. The red indicator light is displayed during charging. It takes approx 2 hours to fully charge the battery.
3. When the battery is fully charged, the green indicator light is displayed. Disconnect the charger from the headset, then from the wall outlet.

Warning: When the headset battery is low, the headset beeps and the red indicator light flashes.

Switch on and off

1. To switch on, press the **ON/OFF** button for about 3 seconds until you hear “DU”, then release your hands, headset enter Bluetooth state, indicator light flashes green and red light alternatively,

Function	Action
ON/OFF	press the ON/OFF button for about 3 seconds
Entering Bluetooth mode	Switch on, headset auto enter bluetooth mode
Pairing indicator	Indicator flashes green and red light alternatively
Play/pause	Press the button ON/OFF
Answer/ end call	Press the button ON/OFF for 1 (second)
Redial last number	Double-tap the key ON/OFF
Volume	Press the button + / -
Reject call	Press the key ON/OFF twice
Low battery warning	Red indicator light flashes

2. When the headset disconnect with your mobile phone by Bluetooth, you can connect by 3.5mm aux cable, one port to headset, and other side with your mobile phone, you can listen to music.

During this mode(2), you can not answer/make the phone by your mobile phone.

Warning

When you use the headset, your ability to hear outside sounds maybe affected. Do not use the headset where it can endanger your safety. Continuous exposure to high volume may damage your hearing. Listen to music at a moderate level.

"Caution" The battery used in the product may present a risk of fire or chemical burn if mistreated. Batteries may explode if damaged.



With the **Bluetoot headset**, you can make and answer calls hands-free with your compatible mobile device. You can also listen to music from a compatible music player

Read this user guide carefully before using the headset. This product may contain small parts. Keep them out of the reach of children.



2. To switch off, press the **ON/OFF** button for about 3 seconds, the red indicator light is off.

Pair and connect the headset

1. Ensure that your mobile device is switched on
2. If the headset has not been previously paired with a device, switch on the headset, the headset enters pairing mode, indicator light flashes green and red alternatively, if the headset has been previously paired with a device, headset automatically connect.
3. Within about 3minutes, activate the Bluetooth function on your device, and set it to search for Bluetooth devices. For details, see the user guide of your device
4. Select the headset from the list of searched devices, pair model

number: AIPRO-100 Plus. If necessary, enter the password 0000 to pair and connect the headset to your device.

Wear the headset

Place the headset on your head so that the earpad with **ON/OFF** reset comfortably on your ears

Place the other side on your right ear. You can adjust the head size

Adjust the volume

To adjust the headset volume, press + button to volume up and press - to volume down.

Calls

To answer or end a call, press the **ON/OFF** key. To reject a call, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button for about 3seconds until the headset
