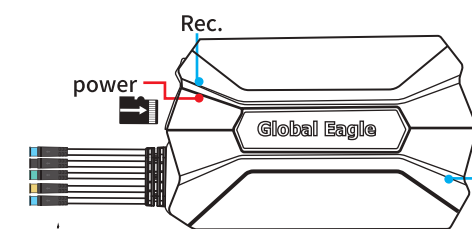
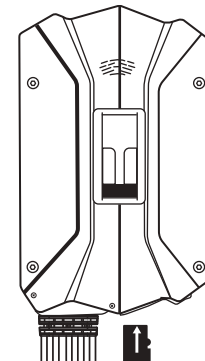


Main Unit Diagram

Main unit front side



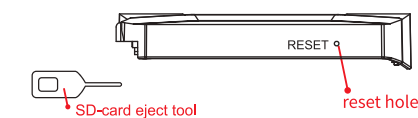
Main unit rear side



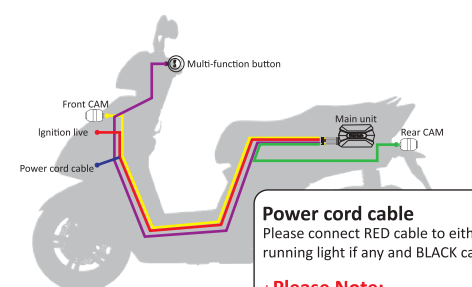
Multi-function button:



1. Recording mode: short press (Red LED will flash once) = lock/ unlock file (file lock according to user recording set time duration)
2. During file lock, blue LED will quick flash
3. Quick press twice = snapshot
4. Long press 10sec. = format
5. Recording mode: blue LED flash = recording blue LED ON = stop recording



When device failure to proper operate. Please use SD-card eject tool/paper clip and press "Reset" which will re-boot



Power cord cable

Please connect RED cable to either ignition switch/ day time running light if any and BLACK cable to solid ground.

*Please Note:

During installation, please avoid high voltage, spark plugs, keyless etc. And make sure cables are flexible during turning cycles of bike

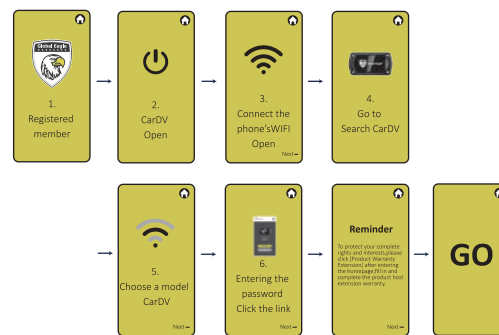

Either press "Next" or top right corner "home" icon to exit



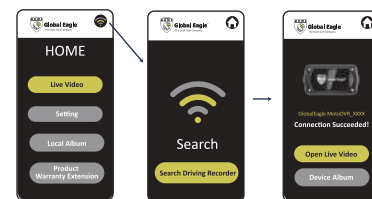
Step 4: Go to your mobile and under settings/Wi-Fi search for your dash camera

Step 5: App main page, press top right corner "Live Video" or "Live Video" button and search for driving recorder.

Once searched and connected successfully, you may now operate your dash camera with the App



*Note:

Memory card: For first time either new or used, please format before using otherwise your files cannot be saved or activated with App. "Live video" are for emergency viewing as using Wi-Fi to view the files maybe unstable and slow, bigger the file size the longer it will take to upload onto your mobile. For stable and best viewing, we suggest to download the files into your mobile.

Remarks

Global Eagle Dash cameras come with a 1yr factory warranty.

- 01.Memory card must be formatted before using.
- 02.Please include warranty card with date of purchase and receipt when returning for warranty repair
- 03.Improper use or trying to disassemble the dash cam will void warranty.
- 04.Use only factory provided accessories such as cables/power cords. Use of non-factory accessories will void the warranty.
- 05.Please avoid high pressure washers directly on dash camera.
- 06.Memory cards have limited read and write life cycle. Please format every month for best performance and it is recommended to replace memory card every year to ensure files are 100% accessible.
- 07.Do not remove memory card while recording, otherwise file will be damaged.
- 08.Please make sure display no pressure is applied to DVR by other objects once installed.
- 09.Do not instantly power ON/OFF again, allow camera time to start up before turning off as this may cause the system to malfunction.
- 10.Do not use the dash camera in contravention to local law regulations for cameras.
- 11.Do not under any circumstances disassemble your dash cam otherwise warranty will be void.
- 12.Please keep camera lens clean for best image quality.
- 13.It is recommended to use GOM, KMP, POT, and MP4 to play recorded files.

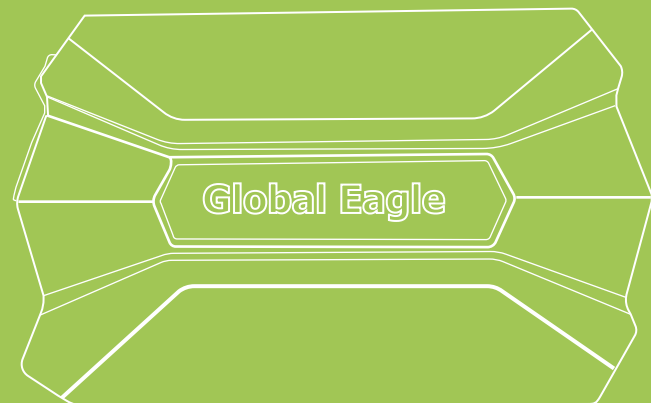
