Bluetooth Setting Steps:

- 1: Connect the machine to power supply
- 2: Enable your mobile phone Bluetooth before machine setting
- 3: Scan the following QR code, download the Bluetooth APP, or search AF Aroma in the APP store

- 4: Enter the APP, click “Search equipment” and the searched aroma diffuser (as shown in Figures 1 and 2), and enter the machine setting with the default password: 9999 (as shown in Figure 3).

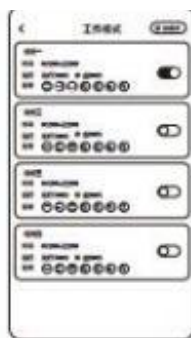

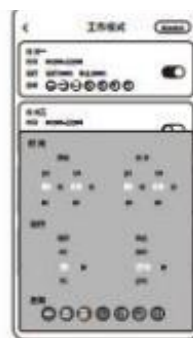
- 5: Enter the operation mode setting (Figure 4). Time, operation and week setting can be found (Figure 5). Click the date option behind week, and start aroma diffusion setting (Figure 6). Time refers to the time period for aroma diffusion within one day (Figure 6); operation refers to the aroma diffusion interval set (second) (Figure 6); and week refers to the date requiring aroma diffusion every week (Figure 6).

6: The setting method for modes 2, 3 and 4 of the remaining time periods is similar to the above.

7: Setting precautions

When the operation exceeds one day, two time periods should be set. For example, if it is to set the time period of 18:00-02:00, (it is needed to set the first time period: 00:01-02:00 first and then the second time period: 18:00-23:59). It is not allowed to set 00:00, or the machine will not operate. The time periods set should not be overlapped, or the machine will not operate, neither.
