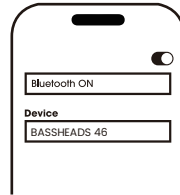

Power ON/OFF
Open the charging case, and the earbuds will automatically turn on.
Manual on: Long press touch button for 3 seconds.
Manual off: Long press touch button for 5 seconds.

To pair the earbuds, open the charging case and search for "BASSHEADS 46"

Once the pairing is established, if you place the earbuds in the charging case with the cover open, they will automatically reconnect within 10 seconds.



If the charging case has less than 20% battery remaining, the LED light will flash 3 times, remind every 5 minutes until poweroff.

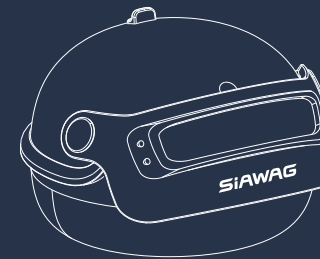
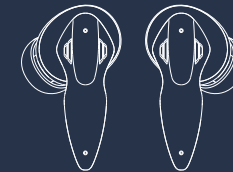
