


OPERATION




NOTE: Light will turn on to last used configuration

LIGHT SETUP

- ① Press and hold the 'P' button to turn ON the light.
- ② Press and hold the 'M' button to cycle through the colors. Release the button when the desired color has been reached. If desired color is missed, repeat this step. **Note:** IR LED is not visible to the human eye. A small RED indicating LED will glow to denote the IR has been reached.
- ③ Double press the 'P' button to chose between Steady or Flashing mode.
- ④ Single press the 'M' button to cycle between light intensity from Low, Medium or High.
- ⑤ Turn OFF light: Press and hold the 'P' button. Next time the light is turned ON it will be on the last set configuration. Repeat Step 1 through 4 to change configuration as desired.


To place light into Remote Mode: Press and hold the 'P' and 'M' button. Light will turn OFF, a green indicator LED will flash every 10 seconds. Light will turn ON with the remote to the set configuration.






MOUNTING OPTIONS



OPERATION

Normal Operation

- ① Turn remote ON by pressing 'Remote ON/OFF' button. Remote will flash two (2) times.
- ② Select the color/group of light(s) desired by pressing the corresponding color button, or the 'Select All' button. Any subsequent operation will only be received by the selected color(s).
- ③ Select desired function:
 - LIGHT PWR: Turn light(s) ON or OFF
 - STDY: Enables light(s) to steady ON mode
 - FLASH: Enables light(s) to flashing mode
 - INT: Changes light(s) intensity from Low, Medium, or High

Entering Covert mode

- ① Press and select desired light(s) or 'Select All' button.
- ② Press and hold 'IR' button for 5 seconds. (IR indicating LED on the remote will flash two (2) times and then remain ON).
- ③ If Required Press 'LIGHT PWR' button to turn lights ON.

Exiting Covert mode

Press and hold 'ON/OFF' button. (Lights will revert to their last known visible configuration)

Leave behind mode

Press and hold 'Steady' + 'Flash' buttons. (Indicator LEDs will flash until lights are 'bricked'. Release buttons within two (2) seconds to abort)

*Changing color of the light can only be done on the light itself.

**Remote will automatically turn OFF after 60 seconds of inactivity.

***'LIGHT POWER-OFF' leaves lights in Remote Standby mode, without emitting Visible or IR.

BATTERY SOURCE: Two (2) AA (1.5V) alkaline, lithium or rechargeable. Do not mix and match.
