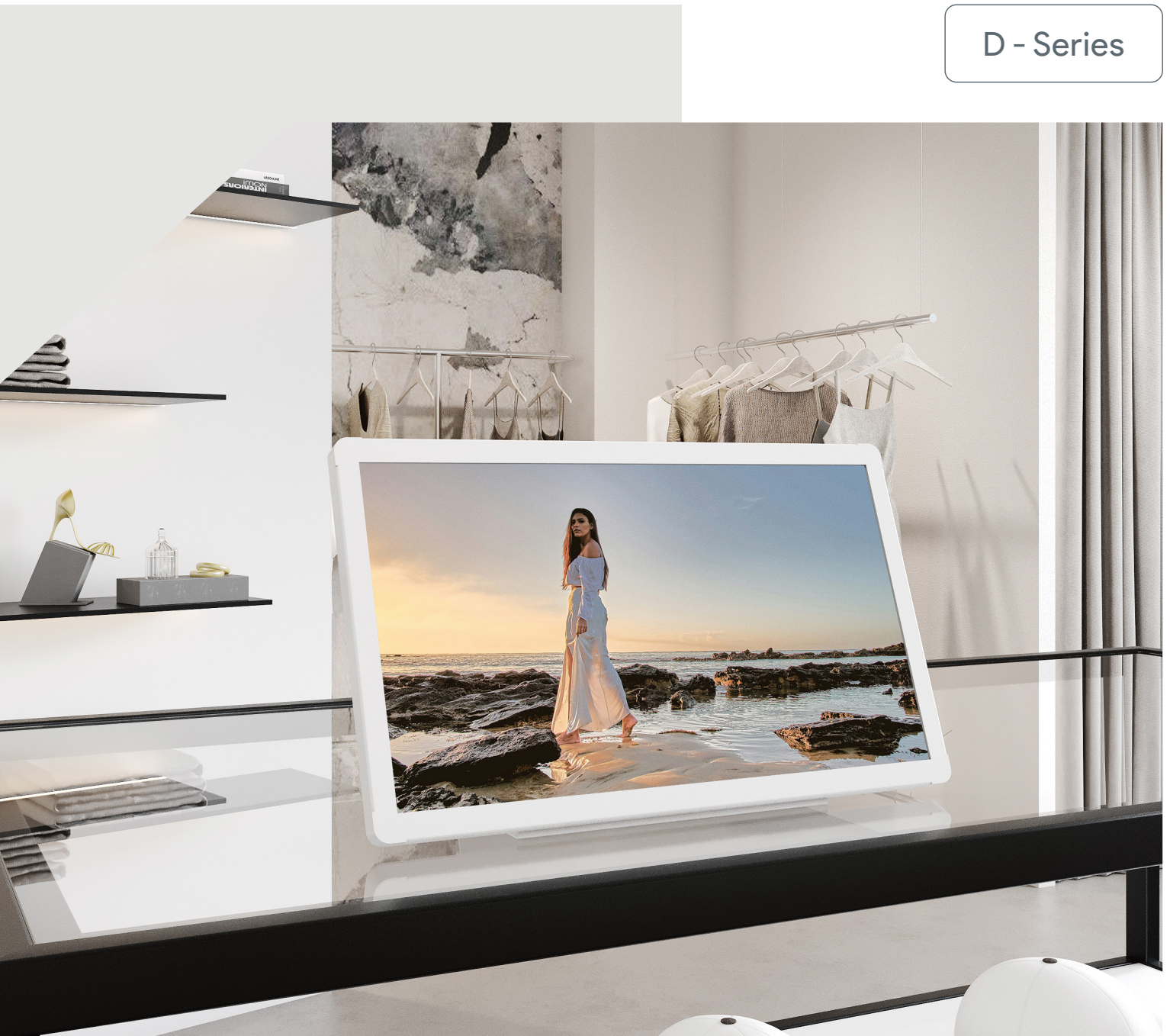

SAFETY WARNINGS ⚠

- Use the unit with a stable power supply. Use only the power cord supplied with the unit.

- Modifications and alterations to the unit not approved by the manufacturer will void the warranty.

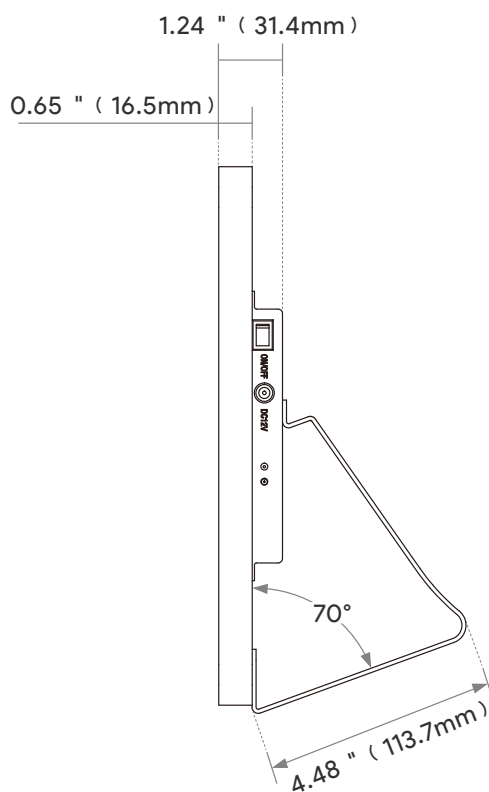
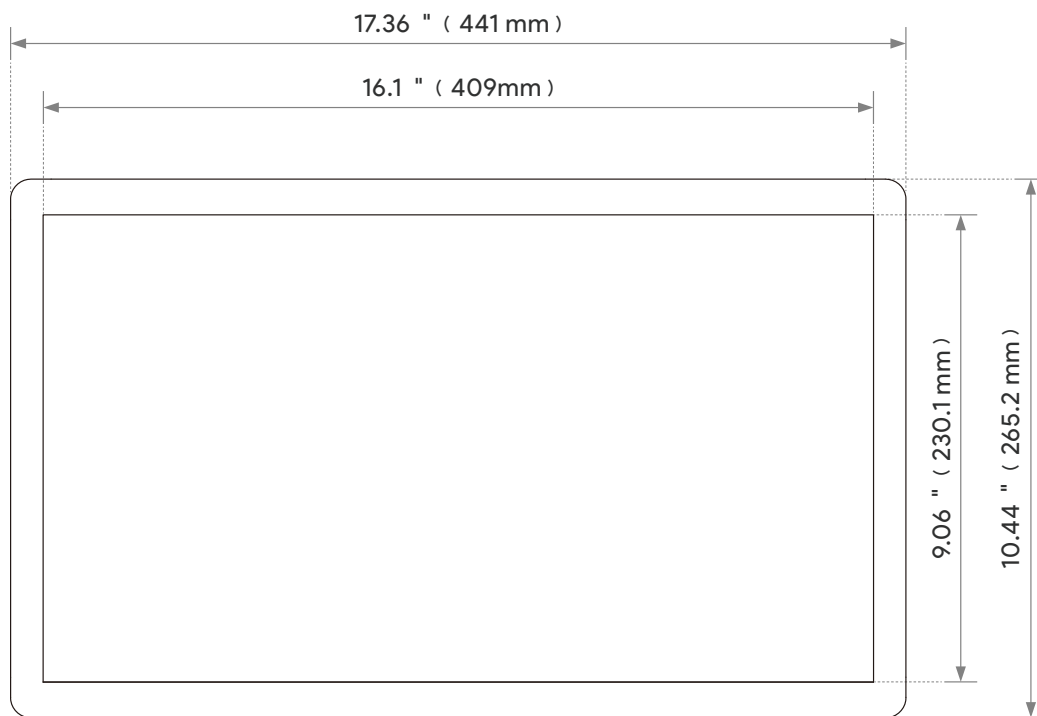

REGULAR INSPECTION

Carry out regular visual inspections. Pay particular attention to the display and the power cable.

Clean the display regularly. Spray cleaning solution on a microfibre cloth to clean the unit. Never spray cleaning solution directly onto the unit. Regularly check the ventilation slots at the back of the display.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Cause	Solution
No picture is displayed and no sound is played back	The mains plug is not plugged in	Plug in the mains plug
	The ON/OFF toggle switch on the back of the unit has not been flipped.	Flip the switch
	The sound is set to silent	silent Increase the volume
The remote control does not work	The distance between the display and the remote control is too far.	Reduce the distance between the display and the remote control.
	The batteries are flat	Replace the batteries (2 x AAA)
	The remote control is held incorrectly	Aim the remote control directly at the centre of the display.
The display crashes	Unstable internet connection	Ensure a stable internet connection
	Roaming activated	Deactivate roaming
Some colors are not displayed correctly	Cables at the back of the display have slipped out	Open the control box at the back and check the cable connections
