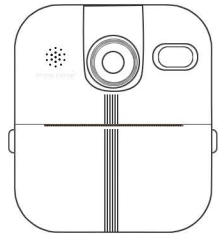


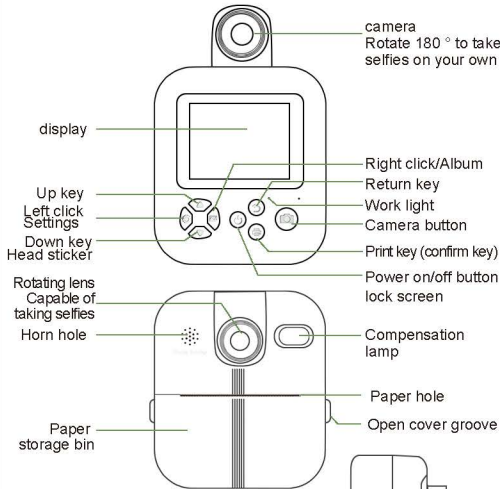
# Printer manual



Please read the user manual carefully before using the product. Contains important information, please keep it safe for future use.

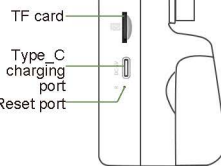
**Warning:** Contains small parts, suffocating. Dangerous, not suitable for children under three years old.

## Button/Interface Description



### Important Notice:

If the camera cannot be turned on or off, if the machine is stuck or malfunctioning, please use a toothpick or steel Insert the needle into the reset hole and press and hold the reset button for 2 seconds. After automatic power on and off, restart the machine. You can restore the factory settings.

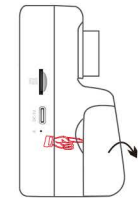


## Operating instructions

Please use the specification of 57mm \* 25mm The thermal printer



Paper size and orientation



Press down on the opening slot with your fingers. Drive outward in the direction of the arrow.

## Power on

Press and hold the power button, and the machine will automatically turn on.

## print

Instant shooting and shooting function

A. Press the print button a on the camera interface until it reaches the display screen.

There is a print icon in the upper middle that appears as 'c'.

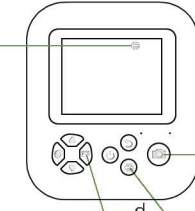
B. Press the shutter button b to take a photo. Print immediately after taking photos.

Replay printing

A. Press the replay button d to enter the replay interface;

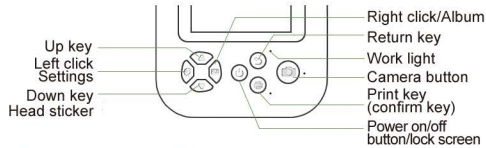
B. Press the up and down arrow keys to select content;

C. Press the photo button b to print;



## Take photos/selfies

1. Press the power button to turn on the device;
2. Enter the first icon in the first row and take a photo on the photo interface. The lens can be rotated 180 ° for selfie mode;
3. Press the shutter button to take a photo;
4. Press the replay button to view.



## picture recording

1. Press and hold the power button to turn on the device;
2. Select the first and second row icons, press the photo button to confirm, and enter the recording mode;
3. Rotate the lens 180 ° to switch between selfie and video recording at any time;
4. Press the shutter button to start recording;
5. Press the shutter button again to save the recording;
6. Press the album button (right-click) to view captured videos;

## Multiple effects shooting

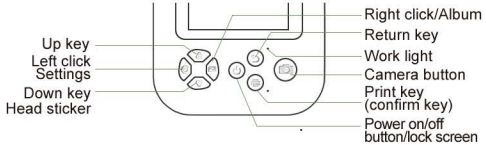
- Continuous shooting: Cancel the printing function and press the key twice in a row;
- Big head sticker photoshoot: On the photo interface, press the up and down keys to switch between the headscarf filter;
- Loop shooting: Cancel the printing function, press the key twice in a row, and press the down key to switch;
- Scheduled shooting: Cancel the printing function, press the key twice in a row, and press the down key to switch;

## time setting

1. Press the settings key, then press the down key to find the date and time option;
2. Confirm by taking a photo, select year, month, day, and time by pressing the directional keys. Select timestamp up and down. Press the photo again to confirm. (Press the back button to cancel the setting)

## Language settings

1. Press the settings button to enter and find the language settings option, then press the photo button to confirm;
2. Press the up and down keys to select the corresponding language;
3. Press the photo button to confirm the selection;



## Flash settings

1. Press the settings button to enter the settings interface, and confirm with the photo button;
2. Press the up and down keys to select the flash mode;
3. Press the photo button to confirm the selection;

## Key tone control

1. Press the settings button to enter the settings interface, and confirm with the photo button;
2. Find the key tone and press the up and down keys to select the on or off state;
3. Press the photo button to confirm the selection;

## format

1. Press the settings button to enter the settings interface;
2. Find the formatting option and press the photo button to confirm;
3. Press the up and down keys to select the mode;
4. Press the photo button to confirm formatting, and press the return button to cancel;

## autoplay

1. In the photo interface, press the replay button to replay the pictures in the TF card;
2. The third icon in the first row allows you to view images or a certain video clip;

## delete

1. Enter the third icon album in the first row; Press the photo button to confirm;
2. Left click to select the image or video that needs to be deleted;
3. Press the up and down keys to select the mode, and the photo button is the confirm button;
4. Press the return button to cancel the deletion;

## charge

When the machine shows a low voltage prompt and shuts down, it needs to be charged. The charging cable uses a Type-C plug, and the power adapter uses DC 5V/2A. When charging, the machine displays a blue light and goes out when fully charged.

## be careful!

The built-in 7.4V battery is non-removable and non-replaceable. If it is damaged, please contact service for assistance repair. The charger is used by an adult or under adult supervision; The charger is not for playing. Use the device according to the charging specifications of 5V/2A; Toys should be charged before cleaning. The device is disconnected.

Flash lamp	On: open flash lamp. Off: it will off. Auto: no photo would be open
Video resolution	1080P, it will show FHD on video screen. 720P, it will show HD on video screen.
Date stamp	Enabled to display the time on photos
Language	Multiple languages are available
Beep/Button Sound	On: the key tone is on. Off: the key tone is off
Screen savers	Set the screen off time: Off, 3mins, 5mins, 10mins
Auto power off	Set the automatic shutdown time. Off, 3mins, 5mins,
Format	Clear all data. NOTE: All data will be cleared and please be careful to set
Date/time	Set the machine time

## Time-lapse/Burst shooting

After entering the photo mode, short press the [▲]/[▼] buttons to select time-lapse/ burst shooting

## Warm Reminder:

Please first enter [Settings] -- [Print after capture] -- select [Off]. Time-lapse and burst shooting can only take effect after the [Print after capture] function is turned off.

## After entering photo mode:

Time-lapse: After this logo [ ] appears on the screen, short press the [ ] key to achieve time-lapse shooting 3S, 5S, 10S. Burst shooting: After this logo [ ] appears on the screen, short press the [ ] key to achieve burst shooting of 3pic, 5pic, time-lapse 5S burst shooting 3pic. Note: in video mode, time-lapse/ burst shooting are not supported.
