



K07 Helmet headphones

Please read this manual carefully before using the product and keep it properly



Installation tutorial

Fixed installation by clamps

Step 1



Secure the product to the back clip, back clip, and helmet.
Attach Velcro separately to fix it, and pull the steel clip.
Simply fix it to the left edge of the helmet.

Step 2



Stick the headphone Velcro separately into the
Bluetooth headphone groove on the inside of the helmet.

Step 3



Attach the speakers to the Velcro positions
on both sides of the helmet.
(Short line horn on the left, long line horn on the right)

Step 4



Attach the microphone Velcro to the inside of the helmet
near the mouth. Then fix the microphone
(organize the cable and taping).

Step 5



Insert the plug into the headphone jack.





Key operation instructions


Power on button

Power on: press and hold for 3 seconds in the shutdown state, hear "power on";
Flashing red, blue, green and orange lights, The ambient light is on)




Boost

Power off: press and hold for 5 seconds in the power on state, "hear Power off", Ambient light for 1 second




Pairing mode

Pairing mode (When the device is powered on, the red, blue, green and orange light blinks, and the phone Bluetooth is turned on to search for K07. After connecting the mobile phone, the red, blue, green and orange lights are bright)



Answer

Answer the phone (power down in the connection state, short press to answer the phone)




Terminate a call

Terminate a call (short press to end a call)



Reject call

Terminate a call (Long press for 2 seconds)



Music play/pause tap on music

Terminate a call (short press to end a call)



Volume+keys

Volume plus/Volume playing music(short press);Next song(when music state, press and hold for 2 seconds)



Volume - keys

Volume  (when playing music, short press); Next song (when music state, press and hold for 2 seconds)



In intercom, on a call, in music Short press/Long press for 2 seconds magnify/Next song


Voice assistant

Single player voice assistant key, summon voice assistant




Atmosphere lights


After successfully pairing the ambient light, it will remain on for a long time. Click the power button to play/pause music; Double click the power button to turn on/off the flashlight; Press the power button three times to turn on/off the ambient light.



Bluetooth indications and prompts

Power on status (when Bluetooth connection is successful, the ambient light stays on)





Notes
