Safety and Warning

1.Placement

- . Do not block any of the device's cooling vents .
- . Do not place the device in an unstable, tilting or falling place.
- . Do not place the device next to equipment that emits high levels of radiation.
- . Do not place the device in wet or dripping places.
- . Do not insert any objects into or inside the device .
- . Do not place heavy objects on the device

2. Power supply

- . Use a domestic power supply that meets the voltage value of the adapter included in the device's accessories, ensure proper grounding, and use only the accessories/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- . Unplug the power cord in case of thunderstorms, lightning and prolonged use.
- . Unplug the power supply when the room is unoccupied or when it is not used for a long period of time.
- . Avoid physical or mechanical damage to the power cord, especially to the plug, and prevent it from being stepped on or crushed.
- . The power cord supplied with the device is for this device only, please do not use it for other devices.
- . The charging port of the device must be connected to the port specified in the instructions, otherwise it will cause a short circuit or open circuit.
- . Do not move the device while it is charging or connected to external cables.

Do not move the device while it is charging or connected to external cables. When unplugging the device, please hold the plug and do not pull the cable.

3.Screen

- . Do not use hard or sharp objects to write on the screen.
- . To clean the screen, unplug it from the power supply.
- . Wipe the screen with a soft, dust-free, dry cloth.
- . Do not use water or spray cleaners to clean the device.
- . Do not adjust the brightness to the maximum for a long time
- . Please use your finger to gently select the item when touching it
- . If the screen is wet or watery, the touch may not work properly.
- . Touching the screen while wearing gloves or touching the tip of a fingernail may prevent the touch from functioning correctly

4.Temperature

- . Do not place the device near heat generating objects such as electric heaters or radiators or other heat sources.
- . When the device is moved from a low-temperature area to a high-temperature area, please leave it for a while before turning it on to prevent condensation inside the device from fully radiating.

Please leave it for a while before turning on the device. Normal working temperature of the device is 0-40 °C storage temperature -20 °C -60 °C.

5. Humidity

- . Do not expose the device to rain, humidity or near water Please make sure the room is dry and cool!
- . Normal working humidity of the device is 10%—80%, storage humidity is less than 85%.

6. Ventilation

. Please place the device in a ventilated place to ensure good heat dissipation, the whole device left and right and 10 centimeters behind the top 20 centimeters above the space of the ventilation

7. Standby

. Short press of the button on the body will not completely shut down the device, but only let the device in standby mode.

8. Battery

- . The batteries used in the remote control of this device must be disposed of properly and recycled.
- . Do not allow children to touch the remote control battery, do not put the battery into the fire to avoid danger!
- . Remote control battery installation should pay attention to the polarity, long time no use need to remove the battery.
- . The built-in storage battery of the equipment bracket pole contains lithium, please do not disassemble, otherwise it will lead to electric shock, injury or fire.
- . The storage battery is 10500mAh, it takes about 5 hours to fully charge the battery and should not exceed 12 hours.
- . The battery life and usage time of the storage battery after charging will decrease proportionally with the time and length of use of the product.
- . Energy Storage Battery batteries cannot be charged at temperatures below 0°C.
- . Even when the storage battery is not in use, the remaining battery power will naturally decrease.
- . In order to prolong the life of the battery, it is important to charge the battery after a period of time, rather than keeping it fully charged all the time.
- . Maintaining a storage battery at 50% helps to extend battery life.

- . The maximum usage time of the storage battery after charging is 5 hours.
- . The standard operating times in this manual are based on measured values. Therefore, the actual time may vary depending on the conditions of use.
- . The operating time may vary depending on a variety of factors, such as the connected device, the operating temperature, the operating time and the user's settings.
- . If the storage battery is completely dead and not used for a long period of time, it may not be recharged at all in the future or the battery life may be reduced.
- . If the battery leaks, stop using it immediately and avoid contact with skin and eyes, which may cause blindness or burns.
- . Dispose of the battery in the correct manner depending on the country and region.

9. Cleaning Requirements

- . There are heat dissipation holes on the back of the product, please be careful of foreign objects penetrating into the battery when cleaning.
- . Do not spray or pour liquids directly into the device.
- . Use a soft, dry cloth and a moderate amount of water to clean.
- . Do not use chemicals for cleaning.

10. Maintenance Precautions

. 11. For children



Installation Instructions


1. Take out the installation tool

Open the package, take out the base, remove the bottom center tool cover and take out the tool.




2.Installation of floor stand

Take out the folded pole and unfold it and use a tool to lock the 2 screws at the joint.




3.Installation of base


- A) Take out the M10 accessory screws and Φ 20 spacers.
- B) Insert the riser into the base with the riser charging port aligned with the edge of the base.
- C) Use a large tool to secure and lock it in place.





4.Installation of display screen

- A) Take out the monitor and the M5 screws from the accessories, it need two peoples.
- B) Align the holes on the back of the monitor with the VESA limiters (one person is required to prevent the monitor from sliding down).
- C) Turn the dial clockwise
- D) Lock the 4 M5 screws with a medium tool.
- E) Assemble the turntable counter-clockwise.




6. Home Page

Hidden operation

Swipe up and down on the left side of the screen to adjust the brightness; swipe up and down on the right side of the screen to adjust the sound volume; swipe down at the top of the screen to open the shortcut commands and notification signals.

Tap the shortcut card for more than one second and let go, you can change the application.






Common Settings

- 1. Network Connection
- a. Click the Home Settings button

- c. WLAN
- d. Open the search network, select the network you want to connect, enter the password and click Connect.
- 2. Bluetooth connection









Miracast:If you turn it off, you can't cast via OS system mirroring.







Problem shooting

1.Unable to turn on device

- . Button indicator light on, can not be turned on, test external wiring.
- . New model won't turn on, the contact magnet is not in place.
- . If the battery is too low, it will not turn on. Connect to power source or charge battery.
- . If the battery temperature is too high, it will not turn on. Please stop using it and wait for the battery to cool down before turning it on again.
- . The storage battery is consumed to its own power off, then plug in the adapter to charge, need to wait for a certain period of time to turn on the power.
- . Rear end toggle switch is correctly positioned.

2. The power is on, but the screen comes on later

. This is due to a noise removal procedure that eliminates any possible noise that may occur during power-up. This does not indicate a product failure.

3.Unable to use the remote control

- . Replacing the batteries in the remote control.
- . Too far away from equipment.
- . There are obstacles between the remote control and the equipment, such as wall obstacles, metal partitions, etc.
- . Bluetooth remote control needs to be matched to the device.
- . Interference between the same frequencies within the premises, e.g. microwave ovens, radios, etc.
- . Check battery polarity.

4.Sudden power off

- . Unplugging External Connections Causes Internal Board Protection.
- . It is possible that the internal protection circuit is activated by an abnormal or excessive increase in the internal temperature of the device.
- . If the battery is too low, the unit will shut down, connect to a power source or charge the battery.

5.No signal from external HDMI

- . Determining if an external signal source is normal
- . This device HDMI1.4 version, receive 1920 * 1080 resolution below
- . Check the version of HDMI access cable
- . Checking the power-on setting of the external signaling device

6.Display Exception

- . Determine the original image
- . External HDMI device best resolution 1920*1080
- . The external HDMI cable is version 1.4 or higher and is not damaged
- . Determine whether the HDMI signal 16:9 picture
- . Check if the HDM signal is under the corresponding channel
- . Check whether the set-top box is set and HDMI signal is output.
- . Check if the color inversion or eye protection mode is enabled in the shortcut commands.
- . Make sure whether the app supports horizontal and vertical screen.

7.USB flash drive won't play

- . Make sure the flash drive is working. The file won't be a copy
- . Make sure the picture playback format and resolution are supported
- . Make sure that the video format, decoding, subtitle format and stream are supported by the computer
- . Determining if the playback audio format, bit rate, and sampling frequency are natively supported

8. Unable access the internet

- . The network is not connected to the network when the network is blocked in the external connection status area.
- . The network is connected, but you cannot access the Internet.

Check the network settings for DHCP

Reboot the router

Set the SSID and wireless channel of the router

Turn on hotspot on cell phone - troubleshooting device problems

9.No sound

- . Determine if the source file format is supported
- . Adjust volume to mute
- . Determine if the signal outputs are supported under HDMI
- . Determining the cable version under HDMI
- . Make sure the front-end device volume is on under HDMI

10.Reset Options

- . After a certain period of time, the hard disk and memory are not cleaned, resulting in a slow startup, and the user does not know how to clean them.
- . Delete system default apps and system files by mistake
- . Mistakenly set, without remembering where it was set
