► Button

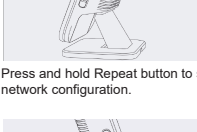
1.Volume+	1. Press to increase volume 2. Press and hold to switch between 4G and Wi-Fi mode

► How to connect to Wi-Fi

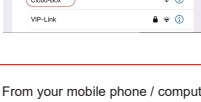
Step1: Press and hold Volume+ button to enter Wi-Fi mode.



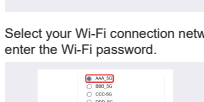
Step2: Press and hold Repeat button to start Wi-Fi network configuration.



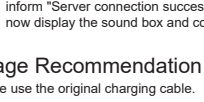
Step3: Connect hotspot "Cloud-Box" from another terminal with Wi-Fi function (xxxx is the last 4 digits of soundbox serial number)



Step4: From your mobile phone / computer, open any Internet browser (Chrome / Safari) and key in "http://192.168.1.1" into the address bar for configuration.



Step5: Select your Wi-Fi connection network and enter the Wi-Fi password.



Step6: Upon connected successfully, the sound box will inform "Server connection successful" and you can now display the sound box and collect QR payment.

► Usage Recommendation

- 1.Please use the original charging cable.
- 2.The standard charging time is 6 hours. Please avoid overnight charging.
- 3.Charge with a 5V 1A adapter.
