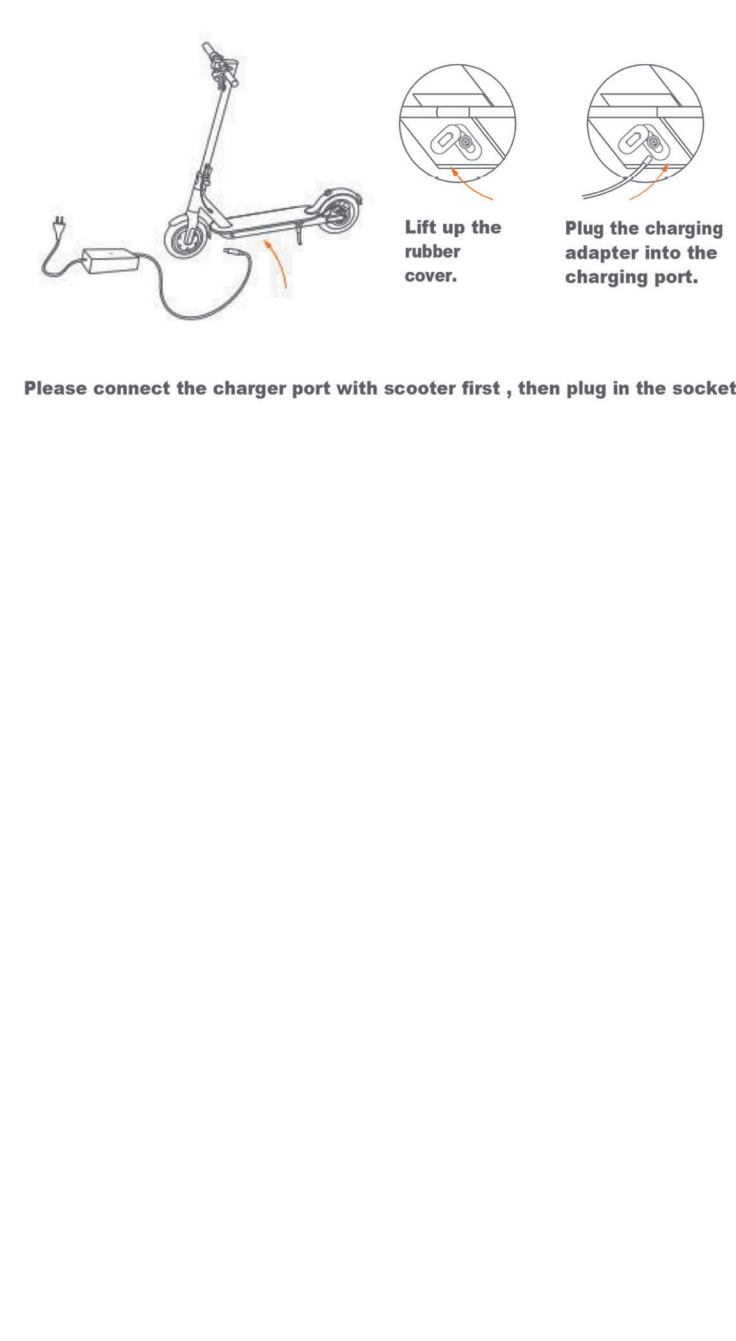
Control Panel & Power Button

Speedometer Display the current speed of the scooter, as well as its display unit settings.
Battery Power display battery level, 100% for being fully charged, 0% for being empty. When the battery level is low, the battery icon will flash red.

Brake Light On/Off switch the brake light on or off.
Kickstand On/Off switch the kickstand on or off.
Motor On/Off switch the motor on or off.

Motor On/Off switch the motor on or off.

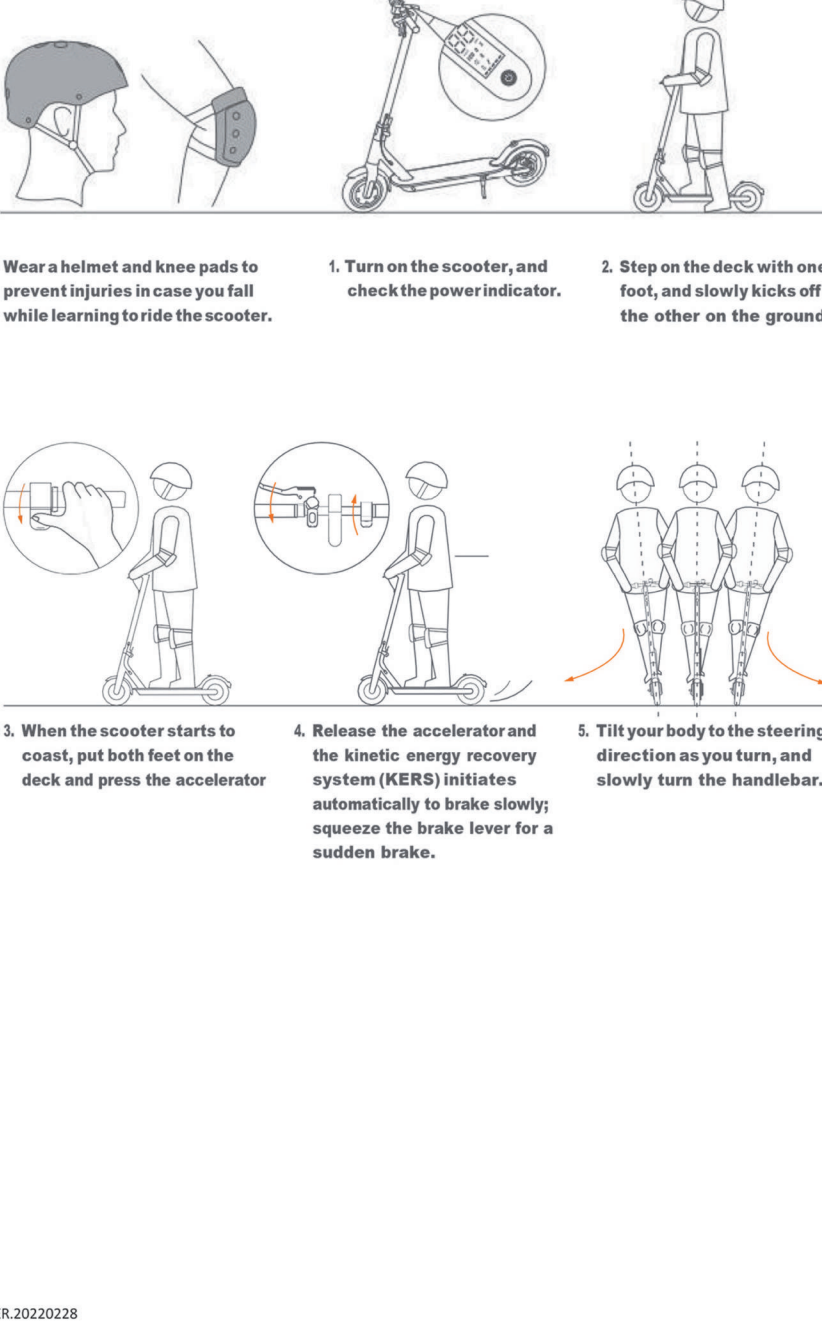

11. Fault Codes

Error Code	Description
Error 1 (E1):	Throttle error
Error 2 (E2):	Brake error
Error 3 (E3):	Motor error
Error 4 (E4):	Communication error (display)
Error 5 (E5):	Overheating
Error 6 (E6):	ECU Controller error
Error 7 (E7):	Motor connection error
Error 8 (E8):	Battery low voltage error
