

Getting Started Guide

1. Charge Your Cross

Place your cross on the charging base.
The base will light up, indicating that the cross is charging.

2. Download the Eternize App

Scan the QR Code: Use your smartphone's camera to scan the QR code below to quickly access the Eternize app.



3. Connect Your Cross to the App

Open the Eternize app on your phone.
Make sure Bluetooth is enabled. Follow the in-app prompts to pair your cross with the app.

4. Set Up Your Prayer Reminders

After connecting, choose from a Pre-Set Program or create personalized reminders.

Maximize your Eternize Experience

Follow these quick tips to ensure seamless use of your Eternize Necklace:

- Scan the QR code to access the Eternize app.
- Keep the Eternize app open in the background. If the app disconnects for more than 5 days, the cross will stop vibrating.
- Plan ahead for reminders – Intentional responses to the vibrations will maximize your experience.

Care Instructions:

Water Resistance and Care Guidelines (IPX7 Rated)

- Avoid extended water contact like swimming or bathing.
- Rinse with fresh water if exposed to saltwater or chlorine.
- Keep away from water jets or diving.
- Always dry the device before charging.
- Avoid strong cleaners.

Cleaning & Maintenance

- Rinse with fresh water after exposure to saltwater, sweat, or dirt, then pat dry.
- Inspect for cracks or chips that may affect water resistance.
- Use a soft brush to remove any residue.
- Keep away from saunas, hot tubs, and extreme cold.

Aftercare

- Gently shake to remove water from openings.
- Let the device air dry—don't use heat sources.

Important Tips

- Avoid soap, hot water, and steam.
- Ensure the device is fully dry before charging.
