1. Important Safety Information

WARNING: Please read all safety information carefully before using the Lift-Mate Smart Boat Lift Universal Remote Control. Failure to follow safety instructions may result in serious injury, property damage, or electrical hazards.

Electrical Hazards

- Always disconnect power to the boat lift system before installing, wiring, or performing maintenance on the Lift-Mate Controller.
- Only qualified personnel should handle electrical connections and installation.
- Use caution when working near water and electricity to avoid risk of electric shock.
- Ensure the Lift-Mate Controller is mounted in a dry, weather-protected location.

Remote Boat Lift Operation Hazards

- Always ensure the area around the boat lift is clear of people, pets, and objects before operating the lift.
- Never operate the boat lift remotely without having a clear line of sight to the lift either visually or through a camera system.
- Do not exceed the boat lift's weight capacity.
- Use the stop function immediately if any unexpected movement or malfunction occurs.
- Keep the handheld remote control and phone access secure to prevent unauthorized use.

2. FCC Compliance Statement

This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to part 15 of the FCC Rules. These limits are designed to provide reasonable protection against harmful interference in a residential installation. 4. Getting Started

- 1. Unpack the Product:** Ensure all components are included and undamaged.
- 2. Download the Lift-Mate App:** Available for iOS and Android via the App Store or Google Play.

5. Installation Instructions

Tools Needed: Screwdriver & pliers

- 1. Turn Off Power to the Boat Lift System:** Ensure safety during installation.
- 2. Connect the Lift-Mate Controller:**
 - Locate the control box of your boat lift.
 - Wire the Lift-Mate Controller to your boat lift following the wiring diagram / video for your control box found at

3. Power On: Restore power to the boat lift system. The Lift-Mate controller's indicator light should blink to indicate readiness for setup.

6. Operating Instructions

Pairing with the App

1. Open the Lift-Mate App.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to pair the controller via Bluetooth. At the end of the setup, the app will ask if you want to go to Interface Configuration Settings. Here is where you can configure how Lift Mate will control your lift. Go to <https://lift-mate.com/pages/interface-configuration-settings> for detailed explanation of each setting and how it affects your operation.
3. After setting up your lift on the app, go to your lift's home page on the app and test the connection by activating the lift through the app.

Using the Handheld Remote & Panel Switches

1. Your existing handheld remote and boat lift switches should continue to function without any changes

Automatic Stop Feature (Existing Limit Switches)

- Your existing limit switches will still stop the lift's motion if set and functioning properly.

7. Maintenance and Troubleshooting

Maintenance Tips

- Insure your boat lift control box is sealed and water tight
- Inspect wires and connections for wear or corrosion periodically.
- Insure your boat lift's limit switches are functioning and set properly during regular maintenance intervals.

Troubleshooting

Issue: Lift Mate does not respond to the app.

- Check the controller's power indicator.
- Ensure the remote and controller are paired correctly.
- Verify connections to the boat lift control box.

Issue: App cannot connect to the controller.

- Ensure your mobile device is connected to the correct Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, or cellular data connection,
- Insure the lift and Lift Mate have power.

- Try connecting through a different method by hitting one of the top 3 connection type buttons at the top of the app's lift home page.
