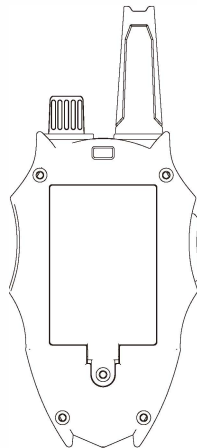
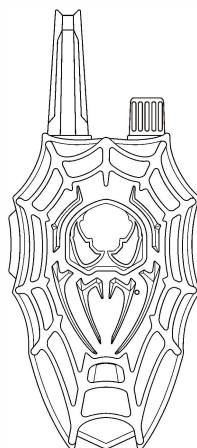

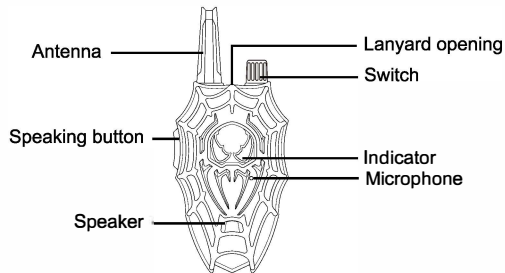

Battery Indicator

- 1.The battery light will stay on after installing the batteries.
- 2.When the battery is low, the light will blink and voice quality may decrease. Please replace the batteries as soon as possible.
- 3.When the talk button is pressed and held, the device is in transmit mode, and the light blinks twice per second.

⚠ Caution

- Do not use outdoors during storms.
- Keep away from heat and water sources.

BATTERY SAFETY

- 1.Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- 2.Rechargeable batteries should only be charged under adult supervision (if removable).
- 3.Do not mix different types of batteries (alkaline, standard, or rechargeable).

- 4.Never mix old and new batteries.
- 5.Batteries must be inserted with the correct polarity.
- 6.Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.

Instruction manual

- 1.Check the device for any damage before use. If broken, do not use it for safety reasons.
- 2.Remove the screw at the back and open the battery compartment. Insert 3 AAA batteries with the correct polarity. Replace the cover and secure it with the screw
- 3.Press the switch button to turn on the device.
- 4.Double-click the speaking button on device A, and device B will ring.
- 5.Hold the device within 5cm to speak.

- 6.Press and hold the speaking button to talk, and release it to listen.



Coverage may vary depending on surroundings. Physical obstacles like hills or tall buildings may affect signal range.
