Attention

Please read this manual carefully before use and keep it for future reference.


- The projector is non dustproof or waterproof.

- Please cut off the power if the projector is out of use for long time.
- Non-professionals are forbidden to disassemble the projector for testing and maintenance.






Structure Description









- Bottom Section-----Dynamic Recommendations





Switch to HDMI input, manage USB files, or go back to Home Page.



System Language, Time Zone, Display Settings, Projection Mode, Network, Bluetooth, Keystone Correction, Focus, and System Information.


