FAQ

Can I skip the Mana Setup?

Yes, just switch ON Mana via the ON/OFF switch on the top and Mana will start working in ~ 2 mins. If you'd like to like to change the content on your Mana then you'll need to do the Wi-Fi setup (one time only) and use the smartphone app to create / choose your topics

What kind of display does Mana have?

Mana has a screen made of electronic paper (E-Ink Spectra epaper). In contrast to conventional display screens, epaper uses pigments to reflect light rather than emit it. This gives the display a natural appearance similar to printed paper.

How do i check the battery level ?

The battery level can be seen when you enter the Settings Menu. (does not update dynamically)
Recharge via the usb port (~3 hours) to reach full capacity.

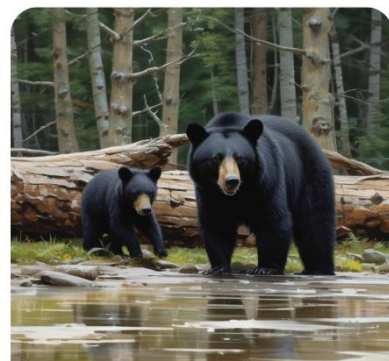

E-Paper Display



The screen is flashing,
Why is that ?

Mana uses a special ultra low power, e-paper display with black, white, red and yellow colored pigments.

The normal operating mode is black and white (~1s fast refresh).

Rendering in color is slow and takes ~ 20 seconds with the display refreshing multiple times to be able to collect all the pigment and drive them to the correct pixels.

Warning: Some people may be sensitive to such a flicker and should avoid viewing the screen refresh.

Interaction



Can I touch it ?

Single button operation using the external touch input sensor



ON/OFF switch
can start/restart/switchoff the device

Touch button supports two kinds of actions
- **Short touch selects the next item**
- **Long touch executes the selected item.**

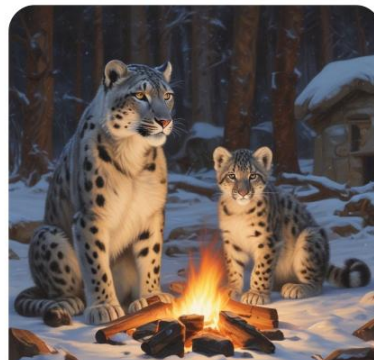
Tip: A short touch on the quotes screen will quickly show you the next quote in black and white. Leave it alone for a few seconds and it will render cleanly in color via a slow refresh

Now for the Wi-Fi Setup,
follow my instructions carefully..
first time setup is a bit cumbersome

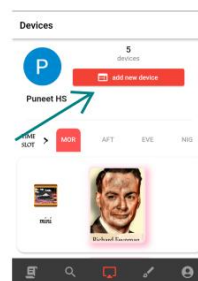


- 1) Install the Kraftlore app on your phone (QR link above)
- 2) Login to Kraftlore
- 3) Connect your phone to your home's Wi-Fi (2.4 Ghz only for Mana Clue)
- 4) Keep location/GPS ON (steps 3-4 needed only during Mana Wi-Fi Setup)
- 5) Go to the devices tab in Kraftlore (middle tab on the bottom navigation bar)

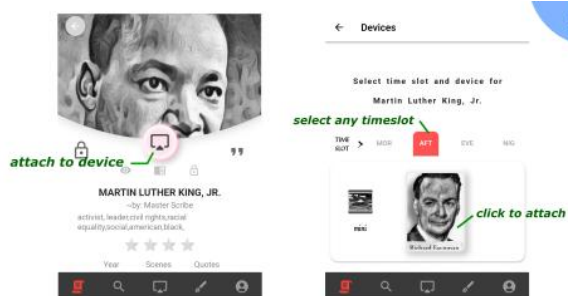

Content Selection



How do I select content for my Mana ?

Using the Kraftlore app you can choose up to four topics (or "scrolls") for each device and assign a scroll for each part of the day - morning, afternoon, evening, and night. Then ask Mana to sync to this.



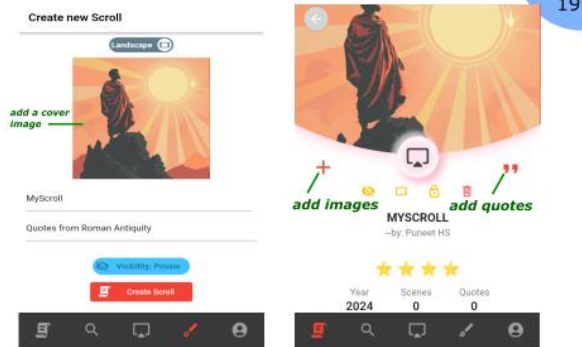
- > On Kraftlore open any scroll then click the 'attach to device' icon, this will take you to the devices page, where you can select any timeslot and click on the scroll presently assigned there.
- > Repeat 4 times for all the 4 timeslots
- > On Mana execute the "update scrolls" option from the "Scrolls" menu

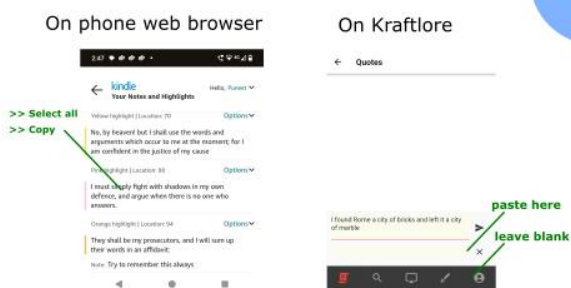


How do I create my own content to display on Mana ?

Create your own scroll where you can add quotes and pictures to display on Mana



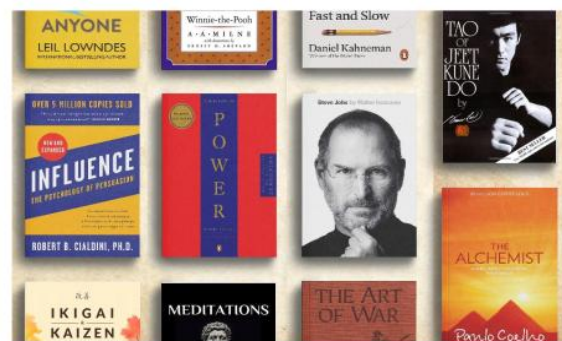
- 1) Create scrolls (4th tab), add a cover image, a title and description and then click 'Create Scroll'
- 2) Open your new scroll
(You can find it on the main page; press the floating refresh button at the bottom right)
- 3) You can now add Quotes, Images or both.
(scrolls with only quotes and no images are easiest to maintain)



- 1) Create a new scroll in Kraftlore and go to the add quotes page
- 2) Go to <https://read.amazon.com/notebook> on your phone's browser
- 3) Open any book
- 4) long press on any word click "Select all" and then "Copy"
- 5) On Kraftlore paste the contents into the quote window and click >
- 6) Edit quotes if required
- 7) Attach this scroll on any timeslot
- 8) Execute "Update scrolls" on Mana

You can also add your highlights from the readwise app in a similar fashion
