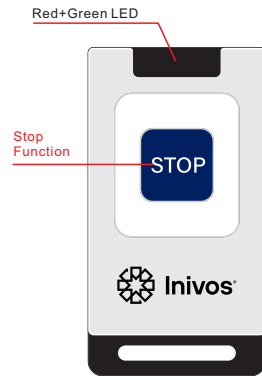

#### 3:Pairing

- Press and hold the stop button for three seconds, then release it. At this time, the red LED light flashes, waiting for pairing
- The host searches for the pairing signal sent by Inivos and will automatically pair
- The remote control is successfully paired with the host, and the green LED stays on for three seconds

#### 4:Restore factory settings

- Press and hold the stop button for fifteen seconds, and the red LED will flash rapidly, indicating that the factory settings have been successfully restored

#### 5:FCC compliance statement
