


Product instruction manual



Product Overview



Important reminder:

Before installing the earphones, please follow the quick manual guidelines to connect the mobile phone and listen to the sound effect and volume. If the sound effect and volume are greatly different after installing it into the helmet, please adjust the position of the speaker in the helmet.






