Important Safety Instructions

Please read this manual carefully before using the headphone for proper setup and operation.

Hearing Safety

1. Do not use the headphone at maximum volume for extended periods. A moderate volume level is recommended to prevent hearing damage.

2. Turn down the volume on your device before putting on the headphone, then gradually increase it to a comfortable listening level.

3. If you experience a warning sensation or loss of audio, remove the headphone immediately. Adjust the volume to ensure you can hear surrounding sounds, including alarms and warning signals.

Warning

1. Long cord: Be aware of suffocation hazards.

2. For your safety, do not use the headphones while driving or cycling.

3. Keep away from high temperatures and open flames.

4. Do not drop, sit on, or compress the headphone in water.

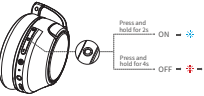

Bluetooth Pairing

1. When the headphone is turned on, it'll enter the Bluetooth pairing mode and the indicator light will flash red and blue alternately.

2. Activate the Bluetooth function on your Bluetooth-enabled device. Select the "BS01" from the list of your Bluetooth devices for Bluetooth pairing connection. Once paired, you will hear a voice prompt "Connected".



Notes:

1. The headphone will automatically power off if disconnected from any device for 5 minutes.

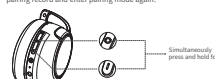
2. Please connect the headphone to your device within 33 ft.

3. If you turn off the headphone, it will automatically connect to the previously connected device when you turn it on again.

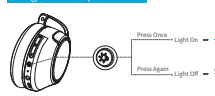
Clear Pairing Device

When connecting another new device, please disconnect the previously connected device.

With your headphone is powered on, press and hold the power button(MFB) and "+" button simultaneously for 4 seconds, until the red and blue lights flash twice and the headphone will clear the pairing record and enter pairing mode again.



Light Mode Operation



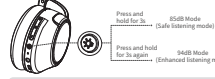
Turn on: After powering on, single press the light mode button once to turn on the light.

Turn off: Single press again the light mode button once to turn off this light.

Volume Limit Gear Switching

1. Press and hold the light mode button for 3s, volume limit to 85dB, you will hear a voice prompt "85dB".

2. Press and hold the light mode button for 3s again to switch the volume limit to 94dB, and the voice prompt to "94dB".



Notes:

1. Both the default power-on state and factory reset enforce an 85dB volume limit.

2. The headphone limit their maximum output volume, but cannot override unsafe volume levels from the connected device.

3. To prevent hearing damage, avoid setting the device volume too high.

Charging Indications

Connect the charging cable from the headphone's USB-C port to a 5V power outlet (not included).



Charging:

The indicator light stays on red.

Fully charged:

This indicator light stays on blue. (Fully charged in about 2.5h)

Notes:

1. For your safety, the headphone cannot be used during charging.

2. Charging is not possible and show a flashing red light if it charged with over 5V. Please use a charging adapter with a voltage of 5V or less.

3. To extend the battery life, fully charge it at least once every 3 months. Battery life varies by use and settings.

Operation Of Buttons

Volume Up	Short press the "+" button
Volume Down	Short press the "-" button
Next Track	Press and hold the "+" button for 2 seconds
Previous Track	Press and hold the "-" button for 2 seconds
Play / Pause	Press the MFB button once
Answer / End a Call	Press the MFB button once
Reject a Call	Keep pressing the MFB button for 2 seconds
Activate Siri	Double click the MFB button
Clear the Pairing List	Press and hold the MFB button and "+" button simultaneously for 4 seconds, in the power on state to clear the pairing list. Then the headphone will automatically enter pairing state

Indicator Light & Voice Prompt

State	Indicator Light	Voice Prompt
Power on	Blue light stays on for 2s	Power on
Power off	Red light stays on for 2s and turns off	Power off
Pairing mode	Red and blue light flashes alternately	Pairing
Device connected	Blue light flashes once every 5s	Connected
Device disconnected	The red and blue lights flash at the same time	Disconnected
Battery lower than 20%	Red light flashes once every 5s	Battery Low
Charging	Red light stays on in charging	None

Aux-in Mode

When the headphone battery runs out, you can connect the headphone to a music device using a 3.5mm audio cable to continue playback.



Notes:

1. When using an AUX cable, the headphone automatically power off.

2. To adjust the volume, please use the volume controls on your connected device.

Hearing Safety Danger

 Danger

1. To avoid hearing damage, reduce the time you use the headphone at high volume and set the volume to a safe level. The louder the volume, the shorter the safe listening time is.

2. Avoid turning up the volume to block out noisy surroundings.

3. Turn the volume down if you cannot hear people speaking near you.

4. If you experience hearing discomfort, including the sensation of pressure or fullness in your ears, ringing in your ears, or muffled speech, you should stop using the headphone.

Caution

1. Do not expose the headphone to excessive heat.

2. Do not drop the headphone.

3. Do not drop or splash water on the headphone.

4. Do not soak the headphone in water.

5. Do not use any detergent containing alcohol, ammonia, benzene or abrasives.

If cleaning is necessary, use a soft cloth slightly moistened with water or diluted soapy water to clean the product.

Do not expose the built-in battery to excessive heat, such as sunlight, fire, etc.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)

Q1: The headphone won't pair

Make sure your Bluetooth device supports Bluetooth.

Move the headphone and Bluetooth device closer together.

Make sure your Bluetooth device is not paired to another device.

If your headphone is not reconnecting to a previously paired device, press the power button to turn off your headphone, then press and hold the power button and "+" button simultaneously for 5s to re-pair

Q2: The headphone suddenly disconnected or turned off?

Auto shut-off may happen after 5 seconds of inactivity to save battery. If the Bluetooth signal is weak or interrupted (e.g., due to walls or distance), reconnection may be necessary.

Q3: How to connect to 2 devices simultaneously?

Pair with your first device

Turn off the Bluetooth of the first device, pair with the second device

Turn on the Bluetooth of the first device to connect again

Now your headphone is connected to the 2 devices at the same time.

Q4: I only hear sound in one speaker, but the other does not seem to work.

If this issue arises when using your headphone with an audio cable, it is likely the cable is not connected properly.

To resolve this issue, please ensure that the cable is plugged in correctly and firmly, sometimes it needs a bit of a push to go in fully.

If you have this issue when using the headphone wirelessly, or if problem persists with wired use, please contact us so we can help resolve the problem.

Q5: Can't hear the other person's voice?

Press to raise the headphone's volume

Raise the volume using your Bluetooth device.

Make sure your Bluetooth device is not muted.

Make sure your Bluetooth device and headphone are not paired to different devices.
